The Drax Power Station bioenergy with carbon capture and storage extension development consent order

SECTIONS 91, 92 AND 93 OF THE PLANNING ACT 2008 AND RULE 13(6) INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING (EXAMINATION PROCEDURE) RULES 2010. NOTICE OF OPEN FLOOR, ISSUE SPECIFIC AND COMPULSORY ACQUISITION HEARINGS. PLANNING INSPECTORATE REFERENCE: EN010120.

Notice is hereby given that, at the date, times and locations set out below, the following Hearings will be held by the Examining Authority for the examination of the application made by Drax Power Limited (company number 04883589) of Drax Power Station, Selby, North Yorkshire, YO8 8PH ("the Applicant") for a Development Consent Order under the Planning Act 2008 ("the Application"). The Application was submitted by the Applicant to the Secretary of State c/o the Planning Inspectorate ("the Inspectorate") on 23 May 2022 and was given the reference number EN010120. The Examining Authority was appointed on 1 September 2022 to examine the application and the Preliminary Meeting was held on 17 January 2023. The Examination is due to close by 17 July 2023. After the examination has closed, the Examining Authority will submit a report to the Secretary of State who will then make a decision on whether or not to grant the development consent order.

Summary of the Project

The Proposed Scheme the subject of the Application is located at the existing Drax Power Station site and adjacent land, at New Road, west of the village of Drax, approximately 6km south-east of Selby and 8km to the north-west of Goole, within the District of Selby and County of North Yorkshire.

The Application relates to the installation of post combustion carbon capture technology to capture carbon dioxide from up to two existing 660-megawatt electrical ('MWe') biomass power generating units at the Drax Power Station (Unit 1 and Unit 2). The installation of this technology constitutes an extension to the existing Drax Power Station (of which biomass Units 1 and 2 are part) and is referred to as post-combustion carbon capture. The Scheme is designed to remove approximately 95% of the carbon dioxide from the flue gas from these two Units, resulting in overall negative emissions of greenhouse gases. The Scheme is referred to as the Drax Bioenergy with Carbon Capture and Storage "Drax BECCS" project.

The Proposed Scheme is or forms part of a nationally significant infrastructure project (a "NSIP") pursuant to sections 14(1)(a) and 15(1) and 15(2) of the Planning Act 2008, as an extension to an existing, onshore generating station in England with a capacity exceeding 50 megawatts (MW). It is for this reason that the project falls within the remit of the Secretary of State's decision-making powers.
