Planning Act 2008 and The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010

Application by Drax Power Limited ("the Applicant") for an Order granting Development Consent for the Drax Bioenergy with Carbon Capture and Storage Project ("the Proposed Development").

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

- Following the completion of the Examination on 17 July 2023, the Examining Authority submitted a Report and Recommendation in respect of its findings and conclusions on the above application to the Secretary of State on 17 October 2023. In accordance with section 107 of the Planning Act 2008, the Secretary of State has three months to determine the application.
- There are issues on which the Secretary of State requests the Applicant, National Grid Electricity Transmission ("NGET"), Northern Gas Networks Limited ("NGN"), East Riding of Yorkshire Council ("ERoY") and Investors in Court House Farm/Delta Enterprise Park ("The Consortium") to provide updates or information as appropriate.

Protected Provisions and Side Agreement – the Applicant and NGET

3. **NGET** is requested to update whether a side agreement has been agreed and signed by Drax Power Limited and whether its outstanding representation regarding Protected Provisions can now be withdrawn. The **Applicant** is also requested to comment.

Protected Provisions and Asset Protection Deed – the Applicant and NGN

4. **NGN** is requested to update whether an Asset Protection Deed has been agreed and signed with Drax Power Limited and whether its outstanding representation regarding Protected Provisions can now be withdrawn. The **Applicant** is also requested to comment.

Heads of Terms or Licence – the Applicant and ERoy

5. **ERoY** council is requested to update whether Heads of Terms or licence have been completed with Drax Power Limited, including the appropriate protection and compensation for agricultural land holdings as well as whether wording is agreed for a potential licence. The **Applicant** is also requested to comment.

Heads of Terms – the Applicant and the Consortium

- 6. **The Consortium** are requested to provide further information regarding whether Heads of Terms have been completed with Drax Power Limited. The **Applicant** is also requested to comment.
- 7. Responses to the requested information should be submitted by email only to: draxbeccs@planninginspectorate.gov.uk by 23.59 on 28 November 2023.
