

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Appendix E1 Section 46 notification to the Planning Inspectorate Dear

Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets (the "Project")

Notice to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 46 'duty to notify Secretary of State of proposed application' of the Planning Act 2008

I write on behalf of Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Limited (the "Applicant") in connection with the Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets. The Applicant is a joint venture between Cobra Instalaciones y Servicios, S.A. ("Cobra") and Flotation Energy Ltd.

The Applicant is proposing to submit an application (the "Proposed Application") for a Development Consent Order ("DCO") under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008) to authorise the construction of the Project. The Project consists of a proposed offshore windfarm located in the east Irish Sea. It is anticipated to generate a nominal capacity of 480 megawatts (MW) and produce renewable power for over 500,000 homes in the United Kingdom (UK). At its nearest point, the windfarm site is approximately 30km from the shore of the Lancashire coast. The windfarm will help the UK to achieve its target of generating 50GW of power from offshore wind by 2030. The Project will comprise of the following elements:

- Up to 40 offshore wind turbine generators
- Up to two offshore substation platforms
- Platform link (interconnector) cables
- Inter-array cables

Wind turbines and offshore substation platforms will be located within the offshore windfarm site and fixed to the seabed with foundation structures. The transmission infrastructure to connect the Project to the National Grid will be for the subject of a separate application for a Development Consent Order ("DCO"). This separate application will be for the transmission assets for both the Project and the Morgan Offshore Wind Farm Generation Assets. The Proposed Application will also cover the operation and maintenance of the Project.

This email represents the Applicant's notification to the Secretary of State of the Proposed Application pursuant to Section 46 'Duty to notify secretary of state of proposed application' of the PA 2008.

Section 42 'Duty to consult' of the PA 2008 requires prospective applicants for development consent to consult on their proposed application with those persons specified in the PA 2008 and in regulations made pursuant to the PA 2008.

The Applicant will commence consultation pursuant to Section 42 by issuing an email or letter (the 'Consultation Email / Letter') accompanied with access to consultation documents (the 'Consultation Documents') to the persons specified in the PA 2008 and in regulations made pursuant to the PA 2008 on the 19 April 2023.

A notice pursuant to Section 48 'Duty to publicise' of the PA 2008 will be published in The Guardian, London Gazette, local newspapers (Liverpool Echo, Blackpool Gazette, Lancashire

Evening Post, Daily Post, Golwg, The Barrow Mail and Isle of Man Courier), Fishing News and Lloyd's List, circulated on 12 April 2023 and for a second successive week in the above local newspapers.

The Project is an Environmental Impact Assessment ("EIA") development for the purposes of The Infrastructure Planning (EIA) Regulations 2017 (the "EIA Regulations"). We are therefore consulting on the potential environmental effects of the Project and whether consultees have suggestions for reducing these effects. This information is in the PEIR – a website link will be provided to prescribed consultees for the purposes of complying with Section 42 of the PA 2008. Printed paper copies will be provided on request.

In accordance with Regulation 13 'Pre-application publicity under Section 48 (duty to publicise)' of the EIA Regulations, the Applicant will also send a copy of the Section 48 Notice to the relevant consultation bodies and to any person notified to the Applicant in accordance with EIA Regulation 11(1)(c) on 19 April 2023.

The deadline stated in the Consultation Letter (and on the Section 48 Notice) for the receipt of comments and representations on the Proposed Application is 23:59, 4 June 2023.

The Consultation Documents that are to be provided to the persons specified in the PA 2008, and regulations made pursuant to the PA 2008 are contained on a download link that accompanies their Consultation Email / Letter and include:

- Statutory Consultation Brochure, which outlines the Project, consultation activities and summarises the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR).
- Plan showing the extent of the Project (see pages 12 and 13 of the consultation brochure).
- Statutory Consultation Feedback Form, which provides a structured method for consultees to provide their feedback.
- Statement of Community Consultation ("SoCC"), which sets out how we will consult local communities during our statutory consultation.
- Statutory Consultation Poster, which explains how people can take part in consultation, attend an event and provide feedback.
- A copy of the notice published in accordance with Section 48 of the PA 2008 and Regulation 11 of the EIA Regulations.
- PEIR, which details the potential environmental effects of the project and its Non-Technical Summary, which is a more succinct and easier-to-read summary of the PEIR's key points.



The Project is therefore an "EIA development" for the purposes of the EIA Regulations and an ES will form part of the Proposed Application.

Project update: Autumn 2023 **Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets site boundary to be reduced**

Welcome to the first Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets newsletter, keeping you up to date with the latest information about the Project. This includes information about our decision to reduce the windfarm site development area to further mitigate effects on other marine users, and what you can expect from the next steps of the Project's development.

Statutory consultation

Thank you to everyone who took part in our recent statutory consultation, which took place from 19 April to 4 June 2023. During the consultation we held 11 exhibitions and eight pop-up events across North West England, North Wales and the Isle of Man, as well as an online webinar for those who were unable to attend in person. Over 360 people attended these events to ask questions and find out more about the Project. Our consultation website was also available and hosted a whole suite of materials and information. This allowed people to take part in the consultation and provide their feedback at their own convenience, including using the online feedback form and our interactive feedback map.

During the consultation we received 168 pieces of feedback from local communities, elected representatives, and other technical stakeholders – all of which has been logged and will be considered. Your feedback is valued. It helped us to make our decision to reduce the windfarm site development area and will continue to help us further refine our proposals. Throughout the development of the Project, we have carried out assessments to see how the windfarm site could possibly impact other marine users and industries. Alongside this, we've been working closely with stakeholders to understand the potential impacts of the proposed offshore windfarm and how we can work together to mitigate any effects.

Through this engagement, and from the feedback we received during our two previous stages of consultation, we are also aware that the Project's effect on ferry routes is a key issue for people – both individually and when considered alongside other developments in the Irish Sea.

Feedback received during our statutory consultation earlier this year, alongside further engineering, environmental and technical work, has informed our decision to reduce our windfarm site development area from 125 square kilometres (km²) to 87km². We believe that this further reduces the effects on ferry operations and other marine users, as well as reducing cumulative effects when considered alongside other neighbouring developments.

Further surveys and assessments

To help us refine the design for Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets, a geotechnical survey is currently being undertaken within the reduced windfarm site development area.

The survey will comprise 38 seabed deployed penetration tests and 15 boreholes, both with a target depth of 50 metres (m) below the seabed.

The purpose of the survey is to better understand the condition of the seabed, which will influence the end design of the Project.

The vessel will operate on a 24-hour basis and will always display the appropriate day shapes and lights during operations.

This survey commenced in July 2023 and is ongoing. It is expected to run until winter 2023, however as the survey is subject to weather and on-site conditions, dates may change at short notice. The reduced windfarm site development area also allows us to coexist better with nearby existing oil and gas infrastructure and their operations. Alongside this, we are also refining our Project design. For example, our maximum number of turbines is reducing from 40 to 35.

Importantly, reducing our windfarm site development area, and number of turbines, doesn't mean our windfarm will generate less energy. Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets is still anticipated to generate a nominal capacity of 480 megawatts (MW) and produce renewable power for over 500,000 homes in the UK.

Ahead of developing our Environmental Statement (ES) and submitting our Development Consent Order (DCO) application next year, we will continue to undertake assessments and engage with stakeholders and regulators to explore whether we can further mitigate any potential effects.



Next steps for Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets

We plan to submit our application for development consent to the Planning Inspectorate and Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero next year.

If our application is accepted, a preexamination stage will begin, with opportunities for people to register as an interested party on the Planning Inspectorate's website and request to take part in the examination process. The Planning Inspectorate will then examine the application, with input from interested parties and statutory consultees. The examination period is expected to be a maximum of six months. Following the examination, the Planning Inspectorate will present its recommendation to the Secretary of State, who will then make the final decision on whether the application should be granted planning consent. We anticipate a final decision being made on our application in 2025.

Assuming the application is successful, we expect to start construction in 2026 at the earliest. In the meantime, we will continue to engage with stakeholders and undertake further technical assessments in order to develop the best possible Project.



Statutory consultation is due to start for **Morgan and Morecambe Offshore Wind Farms: Transmission Assets**



Morgan and Morecambe Offshore Wind Farms: Transmission Assets refers to the offshore and onshore assets that will be used to transport electricity from Morecambe Offshore Windfarm and the Morgan Offshore Wind Project (a neighbouring development being led by EnBW / bp) to the National Grid substation at Penwortham. Both projects intend to submit a joint application for development consent for the Transmission Assets. This will comprise of offshore and onshore export cables, offshore substation platform(s), onshore substations, other associated grid infrastructure and an offshore booster station for Morgan Offshore Wind Project.

A statutory consultation for the Transmission Assets Project will begin on Thursday 12 October 2023 and close at 23:59 on Thursday 23 November 2023. It will be carried out in accordance with the requirement of the Planning Act 2008.

While interlinked, the statutory consultation and subsequent application for development consent for the Transmission Assets Project is separate from Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets and Morgan Offshore Wind Project Generation Assets - both of which will require their own DCO applications.

The approach to engagement and consultation is to seek general feedback on Transmission Assets proposals, including a specific focus on:

- The Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR).
- Refined Red Line Boundary and the location of the Transmission Assets.
- How the likely environmental effects of the Transmission Assets Project can be minimised.

During the consultation there will be a series of in-person and online events where people will have an opportunity to speak to the team, find out more about the proposals, and ask any questions they may have. At the start of the consultation, the Transmission Assets Project website will be updated and include all consultation materials and information on how you can take part.


