As a statutory party you will still receive via email; the Rule 6 letter which includes an invitation to the Preliminary Meeting (PM), the draft Examination timetable and other information about the Examination. Once the PM has been held and the Examination has commenced you will receive the Rule 8 letter which includes the final Examination table and other information.

After the Rule 8 letter, as you have not registered as an Interested Party you will only receive notification of the close of Examination and notification if the Examination timetable has changed or the ExA wishes contact you to ask a question.
