

We are very concerned regarding the construction of more windfarms in the Irish Sea, as we have seen over the last 20 years the construction of previous windfarms have had a massive impact on the fishing.

The impact on the fishing has not been caused by commercial fishing as commercial fishing in, this part of the Irish Sea is mostly shellfish.

The decline on fish species has been caused due to vibrations and electric currents coming from the windfarms while in operation, also the construction of the windfarms using piling and excessive marine traffic in the area pushes species of fish away and never return to the area.
