On 21 January 2025 the Government published a policy paper on 'Reducing Marine Noise'. The JNCC, Natural England and Cefas also published a position statement on the use of quieter piling methods and noise abatement systems when installing offshore wind turbine foundations.

Furthermore, the JNCC also published 'JNCC guidelines for minimising the risk of injury to marine mammals from unexploded ordnance (UXO) clearance in the marine environment'.

The ExA asks relevant participants to ensure they have familiarity with these documents prior to the hearings so that any implications can be discussed and are asked to come with potential responses in the form of proposed actions.
