Notification of Statement of Community Consultation for Oaklands Farm Solar Project

Notice publicising a Statement of Community Consultation

Oaklands Farm Solar Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of BayWa r.e. UK Ltd, of 22 Chancery Lane, London, WC2A 1LS (the "Applicant") proposes to make an application for a Development Consent Order (DC0) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy to authorise the construction, operation and maintenance of a solar farm and storage (the "Project").

The DCO would authorise the construction, operation and maintenance of a solar photovoltaic (PV) electricity generating and storage facility at Oaklands Farm and Park Farm, situated on land between Walton on Trent and Rosliston, South Derbyshire, along with all associated infrastructure including a grid connection at the former Drakelow power station.

The Project is an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) development as defined by the Infrastructure Planning (EIA) Regulations 2017. It will therefore require an Environmental Impact Assessment under the EIA regulations and an Environmental Statement (ES) will accompany the application. Before submitting the Application, in accordance with Section 47 of the Planning Act 2008 we must publish a document called a Statement of Community Consultation ("SoCC") setting out how we will consult with the local community about the Project. We must also make the SoCC available for inspection by the public and publish this notice stating where and when the SoCC can be inspected.
