RE: BayWa publishes Statement of Community Consultation for Oaklands Farm Solar, South Derbyshire

I am writing to you regarding the Oaklands Farm Solar proposals in South Derbyshire.

The proposals comprise a solar park covering two separate parcels of land located west of the village of Rosliston, and east of Walton on Trent. The generating capacity of the project is expected to deliver in the region of 160 MW to the electricity grid, which is the equivalent amount required to power nearly all homes in South Derbyshire¹.

We have now published our Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC), which sets out how, when and where local communities can participate in the statutory consultation on the plans, prior to an application being submitted. This has been advertised in the local press, online via the project website, and via a community leaflet, a copy of which is enclosed with this letter for your information.

The SoCC confirms the start and end date of the consultation, which will take place from 21^{ct} April 2022 to 6th June 2022. Public exhibitions will take place in early May (see overleaf), with a full online virtual exhibition available for viewing during that period.

Following the start of the statutory consultation period on 21st April 2022, all information relating to the proposals (including the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR), feedback forms and summary consultation materials) will be available to view online via a virtual exhibition, at deposit locations around the site, and at public events being undertaken by the developer. The consultation period then closes on 6th June 2022.

Feedback forms will also be available online and in hard copy at events or upon request.

Due to the nature of the proposed Project, an application to the Planning Inspectorate will be submitted under the Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) regime (Planning Act 2008) in late 2022.

Following <u>submission</u> the Planning Inspectorate will examine the application and will make a recommendation to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, who will make the decision on whether to grant or to refuse development consent.
