Statutory Consultation - Section 42 and Section 44 of the Planning Act 2008

This letter is being sent to you as part of a statutory consultation exercise being carried out pursuant to Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act").

Oaklands Farm Solar Limited ("the Applicant") intends to develop a large-scale solar plus energy storage facility, known as Oaklands Farm Solar Park ("the project"). Oaklands Farm Solar Limited is a wholly owned subsidiary of BayWa r.e. UK Ltd.

The facility will be located on land west of the village of Rosliston, and east of Walton on Trent. The proposals comprise a solar farm plus energy storage covering approximately 410 acres, to be connected to the national electricity network at the Drakelow National Grid substation.

As the expected generating capacity of the project at this stage is circa 138 megawatts of solar power and circa 37.5 megawatts of energy storage capacity, the project is a nationally significant infrastructure project as defined by Section 15(3) of the 2008 Act. The Applicant is required to make an application to the Secretary of State for Development Consent Order ("DCO"). If the DCO application is accepted, the Planning Inspectorate will then process and examine the application and then make a recommendation to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy. The final decision on the DCO application will be made by the Secretary of State.

We have recently undertaken an exercise to refresh our book of reference. As part of that exercise, you have been identified as having an interest in the land needed for the Scheme. As part of normal statutory process, we would have consulted with yourself, and any comments received would have been considered in the development of the DCO application. As the application is due to be submitted it is not possible for us to engage in formal statutory consultation with yourself but we would like to hear your views so we can have regard to them and, if necessary, make any changes to the Scheme.

The DCO application will contain full details of the project and will be accompanied by an Environmental Statement in accordance with the 2008 Act and the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017.

Your interest in the land

Under sections 42 and 44 of the 2008 Act, the Applicant is required to consult with those who have an interest in the land affected by the proposed application or who may be affected by the project. Further to diligent enquiry, the Applicant has identified that you may be a person that is either (1) an owner, lessee, tenant, or occupier of land within the project site boundary, (2) a person who holds an interest in the land or has the power to sell or convey the land or release the land within the project site boundary, or (3) might be entitled to make a relevant compensation claim if Oaklands Farm Solar Park is consented and constructed.

Please refer to the set of plans (provided on the project website (www.baywa-re.co.uk/en/solar/oaklands-solar-farm#project-description) or available free of charge upon request) showing all affected land within the project site boundary. In addition, the enclosed plan shows the project site boundary.

The Applicant is already in discussions with all of the main landowners required to deliver the project. The Application will seek to include compulsory acquisition powers within the DCO, including powers to acquire land or rights in land together with temporary possession of land.

Consultation on Oaklands Farm Solar Park

Should the DCO application be accepted by the Planning Inspectorate, then we will write to you notifying you of acceptance under the provisions of section 56 of the Planning Act 2008 and tell you how you can submit comments on the accepted DCO application.

However, with a view of ensuring that you are fully informed due to your interest in the affected land, we are enclosing the following documents in paper copy to help you understand our proposals and share your views with us:

A Scheme Plan showing the extents of the Scheme

We also wish to draw your attention to the consultation materials which are available to be inspected or downloaded free of charge from the scheme website.

How to respond to this consultation

The Consultation Summary Document and other consultation materials (available from 21st April 2022 on the project website (www.baywa-re.co.uk/en/solar/oaklands-solar-farm#project-description), explain the specific topics on which the Applicant is seeking feedback. Consultees are not however restricted to commenting on these issues, and the Applicant welcomes feedback on any aspect of the proposals for Oaklands Farm Solar Park. **Responses must be received no later than 11.59pm on Wednesday 7**th **March 2024.** Responses received after this time may not be considered.


