The application is for an onshore generating station in England with a capacity exceeding 50 megawatts (MW). The proposed scheme is therefore a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project under Sections 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of the Planning Act 2008 and development consent is required.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Oaklands Farm Solar Park Project comprises a proposed solar farm with an associated Battery Energy Storage System ('the Proposed Development'). The Proposed Development would have a generating capacity of over 50MW and would be situated on 191 hectares of land at Oaklands Farm to the south-east of Walton-on-Trent and to the west of Rosliston in south Derbyshire. The solar farm itself, comprising photovoltaic panel arrays, a central electricity substation and associated Battery Energy Storage System together with access, landscaping and other works would be located on 135 hectares of agricultural land currently in use for arable production and grazing at Oaklands Farm. A high voltage underground electricity cable would then run through land at Fairfield Farm and Park Farm to the north to connect the solar farm to the national grid via an electricity substation located at the former Drakelow Power Station which sits south of Burton-upon-Trent. As the Proposed Development would be an onshore generating station with a generating capacity of over 50MW an application for a Development Consent Order is being made under the Planning Act 2008 to the Planning Inspectorate, for determination by the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero.

Continued from previous page... * Description of location of application site(s), or route of development (reference to appropriate plans) The Site lies within the administrative boundaries of South Derbyshire District Council (SDDC) and Derbyshire County Council (DCC) and is located approximately 0.25km west of the village of Rosliston and 0.7km south east of the village of Walton-on-Trent. The Order Limits in total (as shown on the Location Plan - EN010122/APP/2.1) cover an area of approximately 191 hectares (ha). The southern parcel, of 135ha, is to the south of Rosliston Road and provides the Solar Park itself on land at Oaklands Farm. Coton Road bisects the Solar Park in the southern part of the Order limits. The northern parcel, of the remaining 56 hectares, is to the north of Rosliston Road and contains the cable connection from the Solar Park to the former Drakelow Power Station to the north, together with construction and decommissioning access tracks, and incorporates land within Fairfield Farm (in the centre of the site) and Park Farm (in the north of the site). The cable route in the northern parcel would leave the Solar Park at Rosliston Road and then runs north, crossing Walton Road before entering the former Drakelow Power Station. * Is the site a single site or a linear site?
