

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#### 1 List of all section 42 consultees

#### 1.1 Introduction

- 1. The Projects have formally consulted with stakeholders which fall under Section 42 of the Planning Act on three occasions. No consultation has been undertaken with the Greater London Authority under Section 42 (1)(c) as the proposals do not include works within land in Greater London.
- 2. Further information for each of these stages of consultation is provided below in regards to Section 42 consultees.

#### 1.2 The Statutory Consultation

- 3. The first of these consultations, the Statutory Consultation, was undertaken 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023 17<sup>th</sup> July 2023.
- 4. The Section 42 list for the project was generated as outlined in section 5.5 of **Volume 5, Consultation Report (application ref: 5.1)**. Consultees under sections 2.1 to 2.5 of this Appendix therefore all received letters notifying them of their consideration as a consultee of the Projects under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008.
- 5. As discussed in section 5.5 of **Volume 5, Consultation Report (application ref: 5.1)**, consultees within section 2.6 of this Appendix were originally sent notification of the Statutory Consultation as Section 47 consultees, but this position was changed upon further consideration of the nature of these organisations. Their feedback, and the Applicants responses, are therefore provided in **Volume 5, Consultation Report Appendix G1 (application ref: 5.8)**.

## 1.3 The Supplementary Statutory Consultation

6. A supplementary consultation was undertaken 4<sup>th</sup> August 2023 – 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to consult a small group of non-statutory consultees as well as 109 properties which were within the Consultation zone set out in **Volume 5, Consultation Report Appendix D (application ref 5.5)** but had been missed by the original mail out service of notifications of the consultation. The small group of non-statutory consultees referred to above are listed in section 3 of this Appendix and were treated by the Applicants as section 42 consultees (and therefore sent appropriate consultation materials for section 42 consultees) despite not falling within the meaning of section 42 consultee under the Planning Act 2008. The 109 properties which originally did not receive the relevant notification, were consulted in accordance with section 47 of the Planning Act 2008.



7. Feedback from the group of non-prescribed consultees from the Supplementary Statutory Consultation, and the Applicants responses, are provided in **Volume 5**, **Consultation Report Appendix G1 (application ref: 5.8)**. No responses were received from Section 47 consultees of the Supplementary Statutory Consultation.

### 1.4 Targeted Consultation

8. A Targeted Consultation was undertaken 13<sup>th</sup> November – 10<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to consult a small group of new or altered status Section 42(1)(d) stakeholders following changes to the Export Cable Corridor, Landfall and substation designs as a result of design progression and feedback from the Statutory Consultation. The stakeholders notified of this consultation are outlined in section 4 of this Appendix.
