Deadline 1 - Receipt of Written Representations (08 November 2024)

The RSPB has been informed by the Applicant of its intention to submit substantive updates in respect of various documents relating to offshore ornithology impacts, as well as updates relating to associated compensatory measures. We understand the offshore ornithology updates will be in response to Natural England's Relevant Representation.

Given the significance of these updated documents to the RSPB's position, we propose to submit our Written Representation at Deadline 2 (22 November 2024) so that we are able to take proper account of the updated information provided by the Applicant.
