

Planning Act 2008 – sections 61 and 66

Application by RWE Renewables UK Dogger Bank South (West) Ltd and RWE Renewables UK Dogger Bank South (East) Ltd for an order granting development consent for the Dogger Bank South Offshore Wind Farms (EN010125)

Amendment to the appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on **Wednesday 10 July 2024**. On **Wednesday 11 September 2024** a document was published confirming that Jo Dowling (Lead), Andrew Mahon, Helena Obremski, Laura Shorney and Matt Tandy had been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application.
