

I note that that over 40% of the site is BMV. I have analysed all the data relating to the ALC and find the 55% 3b very marginal. There is no research that shows such land produces lower yields. Overall the site selection seems very inadequate no smaller sites have been seriously examined but there are possibilities for this. I do not accept the BNG to be reliable and it has been calculated using an old metric. I note the loss of species rich hedgerows and the potential loss of ground nesting birds. I can also see that there will be a considerable negative impact on the local landscape.
