Itinerary for Accompanied Site Inspection

Further to my letter of 13 January 2025 [PD-009] notifying you that an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) will be held at 09.00am on Thursday 13 February 2025, please find details of the proposed route and itinerary.

Please note that the timings are estimated and approximate so may differ on the day, and if the ASI can be completed in a shorter time it will be. Also, the route may change at the Examining Authority's (ExA) discretion as the ASI is conducted. The route and itinerary is based on the Applicant's Draft ASI Itinerary [REP2-023] which was informed by suggestions made by Interested Parties, although it is **important to note that the direction of the route and the order in which locations will be visited has been reversed**.

The Applicant advises that they will provide any necessary Personal Protective Equipment, which will be required for access to some sites, when the party reaches the Riverside Complex, and provide a safety briefing. The Applicant advises that there will be toilet facilities available within the Riverside complex, however these are only likely to be accessible to participants at the time of the visit to that facility. There are toilets situated in the public house and café at Clydesdale Way.

Please refer to Annex B to my letter of 13 January 2025 [PD-009] for information about joining the ASI, clothing advice, access to private land and cancellation arrangements. I would remind participants to assemble promptly as the ExA will not wait for parties who are not present at the start time, and also that refreshments will not be provided.


