



## Planning Act 2008 – section 61 and section 79

### Application by SSE Slough Multifuel Limited for an order granting development consent for the Slough Multifuel Extension Project (EN010129)

#### Appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on 26 October 2022. This document provides confirmation of the Examining Authority that on 11 November 2022 has been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application.

#### Initial choice of Panel or single appointed person
