CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATION 16


I HEREBY certify that, in compliance with the requirements under regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 –

- (a) notice of the application was given to the persons identified under regulation 11; and
- (b) a copy of the accepted application, including the environmental statement and a map was given to the consultation bodies in accordance with regulation 16

in relation to the application for an order to grant development consent to construct, operate, maintain and decommission Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind (“ODOW”), an offshore wind generating station, located in the southern North Sea approximately 54km from the Lincolnshire coast at its closest point, and associated development to connect the generating station to the national grid (the “Project”). The landfall connection works will be located at Wolla Bank, south of Anderby Creek. The onshore export cable corridor will run south (west of the A52) to the Project’s onshore substation location at Surfleet Marsh. 400kV cables will then run between the onshore substation and the National Grid substation at Weston Marsh, with the National Grid substation to be consented, built, owned, and operated by National Grid Electricity Transmission.
