Planning Act 2008 – Application for Development Consent GT R4 Limited, trading as Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind (the "Applicant") The Proposed Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind Farm Order **Change Request Application Reference: EN010130** 

The Applicant refers to:

- the Applicant's Change Notification of 29 August 2024 (AS-021) and the Examining Authority's ("ExA") procedural decision (PD-008) which responds to it; and
- the Applicant's Change Notification of 8 October 2024 (AS-025 "Response to the ExA's Procedural Decision and Change Notification") and the ExA's corresponding procedural decision contained within its Rule 8 Letter (PD-011, B5-B7).

This letter provides the Change Requests which the Applicant was requested to submit in the above procedural decisions (PD-008; PD-011).

The Applicant notes that the ExA has decided that a number of the amendments notified in AS-025 should not be subject to a formal change request and other changes require further consultation prior to the relevant change application being submitted.<sup>2</sup> The Applicant will be carrying out the

Minor onshore works number amendments – change from landscaping works to drainage works; Reductions in the compulsory acquisition rights sought from freehold acquisition to acquisition of permanent rights in respect of certain plots; and Changes to documents to account for an additional pipeline crossing

Changes to documents to account for five recently identified proposed Public Rights of Way ("PROWs"), the proposed diversions to three of those five PRoWs; The introduction of the Offshore Restricted Build Area ("ORBA"). The Applicant's Change Request dated 24

recommended consultation and will submit a Change Request related to those changes listed at (a) and (b) of page B6 of PD-011 at a future deadline.

This letter provides the Applicant's Change Request for the following proposed changes which were notified in AS-021 and AS-025:

- Change 1: The change resulting from updates to the Ordnance Survey ("OS") MasterMap data which identified changes to the Mean High Water Springs ("MHWS") and Mean Low Water Springs ("MLWS") dataset (Notified in AS-021).
- Change 2: Revision to the Offshore Export Cable Corridor ("ECC") (Notified in AS-025).
- Change 3: Onshore Order Limit reductions removal of unnecessary plots (Notified in AS-021 and AS-025).

Version 2 of the dDCO submitted with the Applicant's Response to Section 51 Advice (clean: AS1-024; tracked: AS1-025) updated the dDCO to reflect the changes that would be required to the dDCO as a

result of the proposed changes to MHWS and MLWS, and the proposed onshore Order Limit reductions that were referred to in the Applicant's Change Notification dated 29 August (AS-021).

Version 3 of the dDCO submitted at the Procedural Deadline of 19 September (clean: PD1-024; tracked: PD1-025) shows the proposed revision to the Offshore ECC, and the proposed further onshore Order Limit reductions that were the subject of the Applicant's Response to the ExA's Procedural Decision 30 September 2024 and Change Notification (AS-025).

It should be noted that the latest version of the dDCO includes amendments which remain the subject of a future change request, being the Changes to documents to account for five recently identified proposed Public Rights of Way, the proposed diversions to three of those five Public Rights of Way; the introduction of the Offshore Restricted Build Area.

None of the changes described in this Change Request have prompted changes to the explanatory memorandum and hence a new version has not been provided.

The only change within this Request which includes additional land is Change 1 (Amendments to MHWS and MLWS). The land rights tracker which was submitted by the Applicant at the Procedural Deadline of 19 September (PD1-072) was drafted following the inclusion of this change in application documents and includes details of the status of negotiations about the additional land.

## 1 Appendix 1: Requested Changes

## 1.1 Change 1: Amendments to MHWS and MLWS

## 1.1.1 Description of the Proposed Change

As set out in AS-021, after the Applicant submitted its DCO Application, the OS mapping upon which the Order Limits and associated plans are based was updated to amend the MHWS and MLWS. This has resulted in the MHWS and MLWS mark within the ODOW Order limits moving. The extent of this change is presented in Figure 1 of the Applicant's Approach to Ordnance Survey Mapping Update submitted on 31 July 2024 (AS1-109).

As a consequence of the updated OS mapping, the extent and shape of land plots immediately adjacent to MLWS and MHWS changed and plot 01-003 was removed from the Order land. The Applicant updated all of the plans that were submitted to support the DCO Application (Documents 2.1 to 2.20, inclusive) to reflect the updated OS mapping at MLWS and MHWS and submitted these with the Applicant's Response to S51 advice (the "S51 Response"). The suite of documents which included these changes was AS1-004 – AS1-023. However, the Applicant subsequently submitted updated versions of each of these plans (PD1-004 – PD1-023) due to subsequent changes to the application, the reasons for which are set out in the Applicant's Procedural Deadline 19th September Covering Letter (PD1-001) and the Applicant's Response to the ExA's Procedural Decision and Change Notification (AS-025), in which the Applicant provided further explanation in response to the ExA's Procedural Decision (PD-010). These plot changes were first set out in the Schedule of Changes to the Book of Reference (AS1-031) and have since been reflected in the subsequent versions of the Schedule of Changes to the Book of Reference. These changes were reflected in the Book of Reference (from version AS1-029 onwards) and Statement of Reasons (from version AS1-024 onwards.

There are three areas (shown in Figure 2 of AS1-109) where the MLWS mark is now seaward of the MLWS mark presented in the ODOW documents at application. This means that these three areas are now considered to form part of the onshore Order land and fall within plot 01-002 on the Land Plans over which the Applicant is seeking powers to compulsorily acquire permanent rights.

Some land previously within plot 01-002 is now seaward of MLWS and has therefore been removed from the onshore Order land due to the change in MLWS.

All updates to plots are set out in the Applicant's Schedule of Changes for Plans. This was originally submitted with its S51 Response Schedule of Changes for Plans (AS1-003) and has been reflected in subsequently provided versions of the Schedule of Changes to Plans (see, more recently, PD1-003). It should be noted that it has not been necessary to make any updates to the Compulsory Acquisition Funding Statement due to the very small nature of the changes.

#### 1.1.2 Reason and need for change

This change is necessary in order to accurately show the locations of the MHWS and MLWS marks in relation to the Order land, and to ensure that the draft Development Consent Order (document 3.1, version 4) provides the Applicant with the necessary powers required to construct, operate, maintain

and decommission the project on land which is considered to be within the onshore Order limits by reason of the change in the MHWS and MLWS.

## 1.1.3 Securing consents and licences

The Applicant confirms that the proposed change does not impact on securing any consent or licences for the project nor will it create any delay in securing such consents or licences.

#### 1.1.4 Compulsory Acquisition

As set out in AS-021, the three areas of land discussed above (shown in Figure 2 of AS1-109) fall within the definition of "additional land" set out in the CA Regulations (being land over which compulsory acquisition powers are sought and which was not identified in the book of reference submitted with the application) because they were not included in the Book of Reference or shown on the Land Plans submitted with the Application. These areas did however fall within the Order Limits within the Applicant's application for development consent, but because they were seaward of MLWS based on the location of the MHWS and MLWS at the time of submission, they were not shown on the Land Plans or listed in the Book of Reference.

Plot 01-002 is owned by The Crown Estate ("**TCE**") and the Applicant has engaged with TCE in respect of this amendment. As evidenced in Appendix 2, TCE has advised that it consents, for the purpose of regulation 4(b) of the CA Regulations, to the provision in the DCO authorising compulsory acquisition powers in respect of the "additional land" provided that:

- a. The "additional land" is treated the same as all other Crown land in the Book of Reference (i.e. the text "(excluding all interests of the Crown)" is included in the description of the relevant plots in the Book of Reference); and
- b. The "additional land", like all other Crown plots affected by the DCO, will be subject to Section 135(1) consent and the Applicant will need to enter into the Crown's standard form agreement.

With respect to (a), the requested text is included in the description of the relevant plot (plot 01-002) in the Book of Reference (first provided in 4.1 of the S51 Response, AS1-029 and included in subsequent versions of the Book of Reference). Furthermore, the powers that apply to the "additional land" will be subject to Article 43 of the DCO which provides protection for Crown interests. With respect to (b), the Applicant is working with TCE in order to obtain Section 135 consent for all plots within the Order land in which the Crown has an interest.

In the Book of Reference submitted in June 2024 (AS-006), Chapel St Leonards Parish Council is listed as a Category 2 person in respect of plot 01-002 in relation to legal easements granted by lease dated 17 June 2004 however having reviewed the relevant lease, the Applicant can confirm that Chapel St Leonards Parish Council does not have any interests in plot 01-002 and their inclusion as a Category 2 person in the Book of Reference in relation to plot 01-002 is an error. The Applicant has removed Chapel St Leonards Parish Council as a Category 2 person in relation to plot 01-002 in the Book of Reference (Document 4.1, AS1-029) submitted with its S51 Response. Therefore, the consent of Chapel St Leonards Parish Council is not required for this small change to the Order land.

Following the Applicant carrying out the consultation requested by the ExA, Chapel St Leonards Parish Council has confirmed this position (see Consultation Report below).

Given that TCE has consented to the inclusion of the "additional land" and no other persons have an interest in the "additional land", Regulations 5 to 19 of the CA Regulations do not apply.

#### 1.1.5 New or different likely significant environmental effects

The Applicant can confirm that Change 1 does not give rise to any new or different likely significant environmental effects.

#### 1.1.6 Consultation

Following advice from the ExA in its Procedural Decision (PD-008), the Applicant consulted with the Marine Management Organisation (the "**MMO**") and Chapel St Leonards Parish Council. As set out in the Consultation Report in Appendix 2, the MMO confirmed that it welcomed the change made and Chapel St Leonards Parish Council confirmed that it did not have any interest in the Order Limits.

## 1.2 Change 2: Revision to the Offshore Export Cable Corridor ("Change 2")

#### 1.2.1 Description of the Proposed Change

The "northern option" within the offshore ECC within the inshore area (described below) has been removed from the Order Limits. In addition, a minor amendment has been made to the ORCP area within the southern route to exclude an area at the eastern extent. The total maximum offshore export cable lengths, number of cables, number of ORCPs and all other parameters remain, as provided within the DCO Application.

#### 1.2.2 Reason and need for change

The offshore ECC presented within Application documents included two routeing options within the inshore area of the cable route, a northern and a southern route: approximately 6.4km east of Mean High Water Springs, the offshore ECC split before the two sections joined approximately 21.4km north east of Mean High Water Springs. The northern route was included as it is situated north of the Inner Dowsing sandbank and thus avoided impacts to this designated feature. The southern route was also included as the northern route passes through aggregates Area 1805 which has an Exploration and Option area agreement with TCE, although this was due to expire on 31st August 2024. In the event that the option agreement was not taken up by the holder, this seabed area may have become available to the project, thus allowing the project to avoid crossing the Inner Dowsing sandbank.

It has now been confirmed that the option on this area has been extended by TCE until 2025 (pers. comms. Hansons via email 1st May 2024), with a Marine Licence Application (MLA/2024/00227) having been made by the agreement holder on 25th April 2024 to permit aggregates extraction within the site for a period of 15 years. As such, it is clear that the agreement holder intends to take up the option over this area of the seabed for aggregate extraction, and therefore it is no longer a viable option for the project to pursue. Consequently, the project has excluded the northern route from the offshore ECC and is amending the Order Limits to exclude this section of the offshore ECC from the draft DCO.

The minor amendment to the ORCP location within the southern route has been made as it would not be technically feasible to install the structures whilst meeting the minimum bend radii requirements for the offshore export cables.

The proposed change involves a reduction to the Order land offshore. One of the options included within the application Order land for the offshore ECC and ORCPs has been removed from the Order land as a result of the proposed change.

## 1.2.3 Securing consents and licences

The Applicant confirms that the change does not impact on securing any consent or licences for the project nor will it provide any delay in securing such consents or licences.

## 1.2.4 Compulsory Acquisition

The change does not involve a request to include additional compulsory acquisition powers therefore the procedures in regulations 5 to 19 of the CA Regulations do not apply.

#### 1.2.5 New or different likely significant environmental effects

The environmental implications of this change have been reviewed to fully understand whether the changes affect the conclusions of the ES or the Report to Inform Appropriate Assessment ("RIAA"). The assessment in relation to the conclusions of the ES is set out in the Environmental Report for the Offshore Restricted Build Area and Revision to the Offshore Export Cable Corridor (PD1-081). The assessment in relation to the conclusions of the RIAA is set out in the Habitats Regulations Assessment for the Offshore Restricted Build Area and Revision to the Offshore Export Cable Corridor (PD1-091). The conclusions of these reports are that the proposed change will have no effect on the overall conclusions drawn within ES or RIAA.

#### 1.2.6 Consultation

The Applicant has consulted with all relevant prescribed consultees, being the MMO, Natural England, the Maritime and Coastguard Agency and Trinity House on the proposed change. In addition to prescribed consultees, the Applicant has also consulted with the Chamber of Shipping. Details of that consultation is set out in Table 3.1 of both Documents PD1-081 and PD1-091, and in the Consultation Report in Appendix 2 of this Change Request. It should be noted that the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, Trinity House and the Chamber of Shipping have all confirmed that this is a positive change from a shipping and navigation perspective.

The Applicant welcomes the ExA's agreement "that no further consultation with additional persons prescribed under section 42(1)(a) to (d) of the Planning Act 2008 is required and that all necessary consultation has taken place." (PD-011, B6).

## 1.3 Change 3: Onshore Order Limit reductions – removal of unnecessary plots

## 1.3.1 Description of the Proposed Change

The Applicant has removed plots 35-004, 35-005, 35-006, 35-007, 35-008, 46-048 from the Order land and reduced the extent of plot 46-045 as these plots relate to accesses which have been removed at the request of the affected landowners and are therefore no longer required. Schedule 9 of the draft DCO (PD1-024) has therefore been updated to reflect this. This change therefore involves a reduction to the Order land onshore. A Plan to illustrate the reductions is set out in Appendix 4.

Proposed onshore Order Limit reductions were also discussed in the Applicant's Change Notification dated 29 August (AS-021) and are set out on pages 28 – 31 of the Applicant's Schedule of Changes for Plans submitted as part of its S51 Response (AS1-003). As set out there, these were Plot 36-001, 39-020, 40-004, 40-005, 43-037. A Plan– replicating pages 28 – 31 of AS1-003 – to illustrate the reductions is set out in Appendix 5.

## 1.3.2 Reason and need for change

This change removes certain accesses and parts of compounds which, following further design refinement and consultation with landowners, have been assessed as no longer being required to construct, operate, maintain or decommission the project. These areas have therefore been removed from the Order Limits.

## 1.3.3 Securing consents and licences

The Applicant confirms that the change does not impact on securing any consent or licences for the project nor will it provide any delay in securing such consents or licences.

## 1.3.4 Compulsory Acquisition

The change does not involve a request to include additional compulsory acquisition powers therefore the procedures in regulations 5 to 19 of the CA Regulations do not apply.

#### 1.3.5 New or different likely significant environmental effects

The environmental implications of this change have been reviewed to fully understand whether the changes affect the conclusions of the ES and it has been concluded that there would be no change in the assessment conclusions of the ES for any environmental topics.

#### 1.3.6 Consultation

The Applicant welcomes the ExA's agreement in relation to the minor onshore Order Limit reductions notified in AS-025 that "that no further consultation with additional persons prescribed under section 42(1)(a) to (d) of the Planning Act 2008 is required and that all necessary consultation has taken place." (PD-011, B6).

Changes to accesses, as shown on the plan at Appendix 4, are proposed at the request of the affected landowners following consultation with them on the proposed development. Details of that consultation is set out in the Consultation Report in Appendix 2 of this Change Application.

Regarding the proposed onshore Order Limit reductions discussed in the Applicant's Change Notification dated 29 August (AS-021) (shown on the plan at Appendix 5) consultation conducted by the Applicant is also set out in the Consultation Report in Appendix 2 of this Change Application.

#### 1.4 Conclusion

For the reasons set out above, proposed Changes 1-3 do not result in the project being materially different to that originally submitted. Change 1 simply reflects the reality of the current position of MHWS and MLWS. Changes 2 and 3 result in reductions to the Order limits both onshore and offshore, seeking to refine the proposals early by removing flexibility and optionality at this stage rather than post-consent.

The Applicant therefore formally requests that the ExA accepts these proposed changes into the Examination. The Applicant notes that the proposed changes are already incorporated into the most recently submitted versions of Application documents and therefore requests that the ExA accepts those documents already submitted into the Examination, as related to Changes 1-3 (set out in Appendix 3).

## 2 Appendix 2: Consultation Report

This Consultation Report sets out, in Table 2, consultation conducted in relation to each of Changes 1-3, noting the reason for the consultation and providing consultation correspondence where relevant in the appended Annex. Table 2 also sets out, where applicable, how the Applicant has considered the content of the consultation responses received.

In conducting consultation the Applicant has, among other things, considered whether it would be appropriate to consult with persons prescribed under section 42(1)(a) to (d) of the Planning Act 2008 in line with the Change Guidance requirement that

"The applicant should consult all those persons prescribed under section 42(1)(a) to (d) of the Planning Act 2008 who would be affected by the proposed change, giving a minimum of 28 days from receipt of the information about the proposed change for responses".

Thank you for your email dated 13 September 2024, notifying the Marine Management Organisation (the MMO) of GTR4 Limited's (trading as Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind) (the Applicant) changes to documentation submitted under the Development Consent Order (DCO) application to the Examining Authority (ExA).

#### The MMO's role in Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects

The MMO was established by the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 (the 2009 Act) to make a contribution to sustainable development in the marine area and to promote clean, healthy, safe, productive and biologically diverse oceans and seas.

The responsibilities of the MMO include the licensing of construction works, deposits and removals in English inshore and offshore waters and for Welsh and Northern Ireland offshore waters by way of a marine licence<sup>1</sup>. Inshore waters include any area which is submerged at mean high water spring (MHWS) tide. They also include the waters of every estuary, river or channel where the tide flows at MHWS tide. Waters in areas which are closed permanently or intermittently by a lock or other artificial means against the regular action of the tide are included, where seawater flows into or out from the area.

In the case of Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIPs), the 2008 Act enables Development Consent Order's (DCO) for projects which affect the marine environment to include provisions which deem marine licences<sup>2</sup>.

As a prescribed consultee under the 2008 Act, the MMO advises developers during preapplication on those aspects of a project that may have an impact on the marine area or those who use it. In addition to considering the impacts of any construction, deposit or removal within the marine area, this also includes assessing any risks to human health, other legitimate uses of the sea and any potential impacts on the marine environment from terrestrial works.

Where a marine licence is deemed within a DCO, the MMO is the delivery body responsible for post-consent monitoring, variation, enforcement and revocation of provisions relating to the marine environment. As such, the MMO has a keen interest in ensuring that provisions drafted in a deemed marine licence (DML) enable the MMO to fulfil these obligations.

## **Ordinance Survey Mapping Update**

- 1.1. The MMO notes that there have been updates to Ordnance Survey (OS) mapping within the Order Limits and subsequent changes to the lines of Mean High Water Springs (MHWS) and Mean Low Water Springs (MLWS) that result from these updates. The changes to the MHWS and MLWS mark within the ODOW Order limits are shown in Annex 1.
- 1.2. As a result of the updated OS mapping, there are changes to the extent and shape of land plots immediately adjacent to MLWS and MHWS. Plot 01-003 has been removed from the Order land and that three areas of additional land are now considered to form part of the onshore Order land within plot 01-002.
- 1.3. The Applicant has updated relevant documents to account for these changes. This includes Land Plans and the Draft DCO. The MMO welcomes the submission of the Schedule of changes to the DCO (AS1-026) to detail the changes made to the Draft DCO. The MMO is content that the grid coordinates have been updated within the relevant Deemed Marine Licences (DMLs) Schedules 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 to reflect the updated position of the mean low and mean high water marks.
- 1.4. The MMO notes that the Applicant considers that the refinements do not result in any changes to the assessment conclusions presented in the DCO application.
- 1.5. In accordance with Section 42(1)(aa) of the Planning Act 2008, the Examining Authority (ExA) have advised that the MMO should be consulted. After discussion with the Applicant, the MMO considers that no further information is required and that the MMO does not need to be consulted for a period of 28 days in light of the updated to OS mapping.
- 1.6. The MMO reserves the right to make further comments on the Project throughout the examination process and may modify its present advice or opinion in view of any additional information that may come to our attention.

#### Conclusion

The MMO welcomes the updated documents as submitted by GTR4 Limited. The MMO does not consider that formal consultation is required.

Please note this letter comprises the MMO's initial comments in respect of the Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind Farm's updated DCO and is without prejudice to any future representation the MMO may make about the proposed Project and associated documents.




Figure 2: The Order Limits at The Haven. Taken from the 'Applicant's Approach to Ordinance Survey mapping Update, Document Reference 13.3.'


