Gate Burton Energy Park-The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 – Regulation 8(1)(b) Proposal to provide an Environmental Statement and Regulation 10(1) Request for a Scoping Opinion.

I write on behalf of our client, Gate Burton Energy Park Limited ('the Applicant') in respect of the proposed Gate Burton Energy Park. The Scheme comprises the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) generating panels and on-site energy storage facilities across a proposed site in Lincolnshire, together with grid connection infrastructure (hereafter referred to as the 'Grid Connection Corridor Options').

The Scheme falls within the definition and thresholds for a 'Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project' under Sections 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of 'The Planning Act 2008' (the 'PA 2008') as it represents the construction of onshore generating station in England that will result in the generating station having a capacity of more than 50 megawatts ('mw').

With reference to Regulation 10(1) of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the EIA Regulations 2017), we write to apply for a scoping opinion in respect of the proposed Gate Burton Energy Park development, for which the Applicant intends to apply for development consent under the Planning Act 2008.

Please find enclosed electronically a Scoping Report which includes the information required under Regulation 10(3) of the EIA Regulations 2017. The enclosed information also formally notifies the Secretary of State, pursuant to Regulation 8(1)(b) of the EIA Regulations 2017, that the Applicant proposes to provide an Environmental Statement in respect of the Development.
