

I strongly object to the industrialisation of our countryside, particularly on food producing agricultural land. We already import more than 50% of our food and I don't believe we are taking the issue of food security seriously enough. The cultural heritage of this area is of a farming community and the projects proposed (4 within a radius of 6 miles covering in excess of 10,000 acres ) will change the lives the communities of 30 villages. The density of the proposals are unprecedented and in a very short timescale. Local people will struggles to interrogate and engage with the NSIP process because of the scale and timing of these huge projects. Solar power is a very inefficient method for power generation. In the UK approximately 11% of the headline claims of the developers proposals, by contrast wind power is approximately 45%. There should be a hold put on all new solar projects immediately whilst the potential of offshore wind is fully explored and exploited. This proposal in conjunction with the others will change the lives of local people who chose to live in the country.
