

I wish to inform you that I still have had no further correspondence from Gate Burton Energy Park on the impacts on my business. As I have previously advised, I have great concern over how this Solar farm will impact my business, adjoining the proposed land. To reiterate, if this development was granted to the land next to my business, my licencing responsibilities would not be adhered to, and would be in breach of my licencing agreement. Animal welfare is the number one issue. Noise levels and vibration during construction, which would cause stress to the animals close by, then after the months of construction would be the low level electromagnetic field noise for animals with sensitive hearing- what will be the effects on this to the animals? The world health organisation recommend solar farms be at least 2 kilometres from human residence, not alone animals with extra sensitive hearing. And also countryside views lost, which is a big factor for owners wanting to board their animals in our care.

Gate Burton Energy Park have not listened to my concerns at all, and I have asked repeated times for answers to my questions, and who will be liable for these licencing breaches, with still no answer. They are not bothered at all about how this will effect my business.
