

The landscape is very definitely NOT industrialised by the power stations. The cooling towers are compact and farmland reaches the edges of the power stations.

Awareness of 800,000 solar panels will NOT be lessened by hedges! The land slopes down to the river and currently has footpaths across it, hedges will hide the view across farmland, countryside and the river, but will not disguise solar panels of this height!

The vast amount of land taken to house solar panels is totally unproportional to the small amount of inflexible electricity produced. Farming would be a much more productive use of the land!

There are better and more productive alternatives to solar panels which are not productive on dark nights, cloudy days and in Winter!
