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1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought alongside the Statement of Reasons demonstrates that the Applicant has complied with the CA Guidance related to procedures for the compulsory acquisition of land (DCLG, September 2013).
- 1.1.2 The Applicant has been and continues to seek to acquire the relevant freehold interests, new rights and temporary use of land by private treaty, in order to ensure implementation of the Scheme. Whilst seeking compulsory acquisition powers, the Applicant will continue to seek to reach voluntary agreement wherever possible. This approach of seeking powers of compulsory acquisition in the application for Development Consent Order (DCO), in parallel, conducting negotiations to acquire land rights by agreement, accords with paragraph 26 of the CA Guidance. Table 1 below sets out the latest position in relation to these voluntary agreements.
- 1.1.3 The CA Guidance states that there must be a clear idea how the land to be acquired is to be used, and table 1 below summarises the reason that acquisition of land/rights and temporary possession is required to accommodate the Scheme.
- 1.1.4 Table 2 below lists plots within the Order land which comprise part of the highway network and whilst an explanation is provided on why the land is required to accommodate the Scheme; a summary of negotiations is not provided here as there are no voluntary rights being sought in relation to the highway other than engaging with the relevant highways authority as part of the DCO process.
- 1.1.5 Table 3 below sets out the position in relation to Statutory Undertakers who have been identified as having apparatus in the Order land.
- 1.1.6 This Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought is one of a number of documents accompanying the application for DCO. It should be read in conjunction with the following documents:

On 4 January 2023 the Applicant and Gateley Hamer met with Mr Hill in an attempt to reach a resolution to allow the agricultural barns to be constructed without impact on the Scheme.

Following registration of Mr Hill's title at the Land Registry, shortly before DCO application submission, the Applicant (via Gateley Hamer) became aware that Ms Emma Ruth Hill had acquired the land with Mr Hill. Ms Hill will be contacted by the Applicant separately and will be notified of the acceptance of the Applicant via the section 56 acceptance process.

Gateley Hamer continues to engage with Mr Hill (and now with Ms Hill) in relation to the Heads of Terms with a view to reaching a voluntary agreement for the rights required to construct and operate the Scheme.

A relevant representation was received from this Affected Person objecting to the proposed scheme due to having been granted planning permission for agricultural building and the impact that the scheme will have on their new agricultural business.

The Applicant continues to liaise with the Affected Person to minimise the impact from the proposed scheme. Heads of Terms continue to be discussed with the affected parties. We are hopeful that matters will be agreed by the end of examination.

The Applicant has recently responded to Mr Hill regarding commercial terms and we currently await his response.

The Applicant continues to engage with Mr and Mrs Hill and has issued a revised offer taking into account their latest comment. We await Mr Hill's response to those.
