# Applicant Letter Deadline 5, Gate Burton Energy Park

## Application Ref: EN010131

#### **Introduction**

This letter accompanies the submission of a suite of documents by the Applicant for the Gate Burton Energy Park at Deadline 5 of the Examination on 20 November 2023.

This suite of documents includes the required certificate of compliance and notice of additional affected persons submitted in accordance with Regulation 9 of the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 associated with the Change Request submitted in October 2023.

#### Report on the Implications of European Sites (RIES)

The RIES was issued by the ExA on 25 October 2023 which included a request for the Habitats Regulations Assessment to be updated to include a screening of impacts to fish features of the Humber Estuary Special Area of Conservation (SAC) from Electro Magnetic Fields (EMF) during operation from the Proposed Development alone and in-combination with other schemes.

The Applicant has considered this request. The Risk Assessment presented in Appendix A of the Applicant Response to the Examining Authority's Further Written Questions (ExQ3) **[document 8.28]** confirms that the probability of adverse effects of EMF from cables buried beneath the River Trent for the Gate Burton Energy Park and cumulatively with West Burton, Cottam and Tillbridge on fish, including River Lamprey and Sea Lamprey, is extremely low and therefore, not significant. This is

because the cables will be buried at a depth below that where effects would be experience (being a minimum of 5 m below the River Trent), significantly deeper than is required as standard for high voltage cables below watercourses. As such, there are no impact pathways which may affect protected sites, notably the Humber Estuary Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

The Applicant's **Habitats Regulation Assessment [APP-223/7.2]** was a pre-Screening Report, which did not identify any European Sites within the studies search area. This means it did not identify any sites that may be impacted by the proposed Solar and Energy Storage Park and/or Grid Connection Corridor and concluded that will be No Significant Effects to European Sites either from the construction, operation and decommissioning of the Scheme or in combination with other plans and projects. The Risk Assessment requested by the Environment Agency confirms that there are no impact pathways from EMF on fish and therefore, the conclusion of the HRA remains valid and no further updates are required.

### Update on progress with third parties

The Applicant has engaged in, and continues to engage in, discussions and negotiations with third parties in relation to the Scheme. In advance of Deadline 5, the Applicant has made good progress with some key stakeholders, including:

- The Crown Estate (TCE): the Applicant and TCE has reached agreement for crown consent pursuant to section 135(1) and 135(2) of the Planning Act 2008. The agreed documents are now in the process of being executed and will be submitted into Examination once the completed documents are available.
- The Environment Agency (EA): the Applicant and the EA has reached agreement on the protective provisions. The final and agreed set has been included at Part 8 of Schedule 15 of the draft DCO submitted at Deadline 5.
- EDF Energy (Thermal Generation) Limited (EDF): the Applicant and EDF has reached agreement on the protective provisions, subject to certain provisions relating to powers of compulsory acquisition (which are included as a placeholder for now and remain subject to relevant voluntary agreements being in place). The Applicant has inserted the agreed protective provisions at Part 15 of Schedule 15 of the draft DCO submitted at Deadline 5.
- Lincolnshire County Council (LCC): the Applicant has agreed with LCC to include protective provisions at Part 13 of Schedule 15 of the draft DCO submitted at Deadline 5, for the benefit of Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue, as the appropriate mechanism to secure a financial contribution for the local fire service.

Further information and detail on the progress of discussions with third parties can be found in the documents submitted at this Deadline 5. For example, see Schedule 15 (protective provisions) of the updated draft DCO and the updated Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought.
