It is clear that this project is neither needed nor wanted. Solar is the most inefficient producer of green energy and will take vast swathes of good arable land out of production for 60 years or more. It is not in keeping with the agricultural nature of Lincolnshire and is not sensitive to it.

The sheer size of this industrialisation and inefficiency of solar panels is so damaging that any benefits of the scheme are far outweighed by the adverse effects on the rural landscape.

Far better and more efficient methods of generating green energy are available and even with solar, rooftop solar panels on industrial (and residential) buildings as well as utilising brownfield sites is far preferable to this destruction of agricultural land.
