Application for a Development Consent Order for the proposed West Burton Solar Project.

Notice is hereby given that, at the dates, times and locations set out below, the following Hearings will be held by the Examining Authority (on behalf of the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero, (the "Secretary of State")) for the examination of the application made by West Burton Solar Project Limited (Company No. 13049324) of Unit 25.7 Coda Studios 189 Munster Road, London, England, SW6 6AW (the "Applicant") for a Development Consent Order ("DCO") under Sections 14,15 and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "Application").
- 2. The Application was submitted to the Secretary of State via the Planning Inspectorate on 21 March 2023, and accepted for examination on 18 April 2023. The reference number applied to the Application by the Planning Inspectorate is EN010132. The Examining Authority was appointed on 26 July 2023 to examine the Application.

Summary of Proposed Development

- 11. The Application is for development consent to construct, operate, maintain and decommission a solar photovoltaic (PV) electricity generating facility with a capacity of over 50 megawatts (MW) and export connection to the National Grid.
- 12. West Burton Solar Project (the "Proposed Development") will be partly situated in the administrative boundary of West Lindsey District Council and Lincolnshire County Council and the administrative boundary of Bassetlaw District Council and Nottinghamshire County Council. The Scheme comprises a number of land parcels described as West Burton 1, 2, and 3 which accommodate ground mounted PV generating stations (incorporating solar arrays); grid connection infrastructure and energy storage; cable route corridors; accesses and environmental mitigation and enhancement measures. West Burton 1 is located east of the village of Broxholme. West Burton 2 sits to the north of the village of Saxilby and surrounds the village of Ingleby. West Burton 3 is located to the southeast of the village of Marton and east of the village of Brampton. A cable will run between these sites and then to a grid connection at a substation at West Burton Power Station. - 13. Development consent is required to the extent that development is or forms part of a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project ("NSIP") pursuant to sections 14(1)(a) and 15(1) and 15(2) of the Planning Act 2008, as an onshore generating station in England with a capacity greater than 50 MW. It is for this reason that the Proposed Development falls within the remit of the Secretary of State's decision-making powers.
- 14. The DCO, if granted, would authorise the compulsory acquisition of land, interests in land and rights over land, and the powers to use land permanently and temporarily. The DCO would also authorise alterations to the layout of streets, the construction of accesses to the Proposed Development, the temporary stopping up or management of the public rights of way, street works, removal of hedgerows and the application and disapplication of legislation.
