INITIAL ASSESSMENT OF PRINCIPAL ISSUES – consistency between West Burton and Cottam Solar Schemes.

Please could we request that 'The medieval bishop's palace and deer park, Stow Park' is specifically mentioned in West Burton Solar's INITIAL ASSESSMENT OF PRINCIPAL ISSUES, - see Annex D 6.1 to mirror the specific mention of Thorpe Medieval Settlement in Annex D 9 a) of the rule 6 letter for Cottam Solar – see below.

In both cases the named monuments have been identified by Historic England (in our relevant representations) as matter of particular concern regarding avoidable harm to the significance of designated heritage assets.
