1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Document

- 1.1.1 This Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) has been prepared as part of the proposed West Burton Solar Project Development Consent Order (the Application) made by West Burton Solar Project Ltd (the Applicant) to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero (the Secretary of State) pursuant to the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008).
- 1.1.2 This SoCG does not seek to replicate information which is available elsewhere within the Application documents. All documents are available on the Planning Inspectorate website.
- 1.1.3 This SoCG has been produced to confirm to the Examining Authority (ExA) where agreement has been reached between the parties, and where agreement has not (yet) been reached. SoCGs are an established means in the DCO consenting process of allowing all parties to identify and focus on specific issues that may need to be addressed during the examination.

1.2 Parties to this Statement of Common Ground

- 1.2.1 This SoCG has been prepared by (1) West Burton Solar Project Ltd. as the Applicant and (2) Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (Network Rail).
- 1.2.2 Collectively, West Burton Solar Project Ltd and Network Rail are referred to as 'the parties'.

1.3 Terminology

- 1.3.1 In the tables in **Sections 3 5** of this SoCG:
 - "Agreed" indicates where the issue has been resolved.
 - "Not Agreed" indicates a final position, and
 - "Under discussion" indicates where these points will be the subject of ongoing discussion wherever possible to resolve, or refine, the extent of disagreement between the parties.





2 Record of Engagement

2.1 Summary of Consultation

2.1.1 The parties have been engaged in consultation since March 2022. A summary of the meetings and correspondence that has taken place between West Burton Solar Project and Network Rail in relation to the Application is outlined in **Table 2.1**.

27/07/2022	Email	A Town Planning Technician at Network Rail provided a section 42 consultation response. It advised that additional information relating to glint and glare, construction and traffic works, lighting, drainage schemes, and boundary treatments would be required to properly assess any effects of the development on the railway. It also provided comments on the legal and commercial agreements that would need to be entered into by both parties.
11/10/2022	Microsoft Teams Call	A Project Manager from West Burton Solar Project Ltd had an introductory call with a Technical Surveyor from the easement and wayleaves department at Network Rail to discuss the information required to start the clearance process to cross Network Rail owned land.
12/10/2022	Email	A Project Manager at West Burton Solar Project Ltd sent the crossing plan and schedule of minimum information to Network Rail to start the clearance process.
19/12/2022	Email	A Project Management Assistant from Network Rail sent an email to a Project Manager at West Burton Solar Project Ltd confirming that £10 million public liability insurance would be sufficient to agree the BAPAs, however, that £20 million public liability insurance would need to be provided at the construction phase.

05/05/2023	Microsoft Teams Call	Call between a Surveyor at Network Rail, Network Rail and a Project Manager at West Burton Solar Project Ltd to discuss Heads of Terms for the crossing easement.
22/06/2023	Section 56 Relevant Representation	Received Network Rail's relevant representation published on the Planning Inspectorates website for the Scheme.
03/08/2023	Call and Email	Discussions with the Commercial Manager at Network Rail regarding the process for transferring the BAPA to be in the name of West Burton Solar Project Ltd.
15/09/2023	Email	Network Rail confirmed that the crossing location for West Burton had passed the clearance process but that the Heads of Terms are still being negotiated.

Glint and Glare NR-001	Outcomes	 No significant impacts upon identified railway receptors are predicted because: Existing vegetation significantly screens the train driver's primary field of vision from the panelled area where reflections could occur, and the developer has proposed screening along the boundary of the development to further obstruct views of the reflective areas. As a result, the effects are predicted to be 'neutral'; Therefore, once the proposed screening is in place, no impacts are predicted and further mitigation is not required. Further information is provided in Section 16.8 of Chapter 16: Glint and Glare of the Environmental Statement and Section 7 of Appendix 16.1 [APP-132].
