# The Applicant's Proposed Viewpoint Location for Accompanied Site Inspection and Draft Itinerary

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### 1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 As requested in the Rule 6 [PD-005] and Rule 8 [PD-008] letters, this document sets out the Applicant's suggested viewpoint locations for the Examining Authority's (ExA) Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI). The Applicant is happy to support the ExA through an ASI. Table 1 and Figure 1 below set out a list of viewpoints which the Applicant considers important for the ExA to visit in understanding the Scheme.
- 1.1.2 The Applicant also sets out a draft itinerary for the ASI for further consultation with the ExA and based on these proposed locations, we strongly would recommend an ASI for these. The ASI is programmed to take place during the w/c 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2024.
- 1.1.3 The Applicants have undertaken a review of the relevant representations to consider an appropriate route and itinerary for the ASI. It is understood that the ExA haven't undertaken any unaccompanied site visits yet. If this is carried out prior to the ASI and locations have already been visited that are suggested by the Applicant then the ExA may decide that some of the suggested viewpoints are not required to revisit.
- 1.1.4 The proposed ASI route and itinerary is intended to focus on the key areas of discussion following a review of the stakeholder engagement and consultation responses. The Applicant would welcome further comments from the ExA and other consultees to finalise an agreed route and itinerary for the ASI.
- 1.1.5 The Applicant proposes to hire a minibus(es) to aid transit around the site. Given the dispersed nature of the viewpoints it is considered more efficient and safer for all parties to travel in a minibus. Once the numbers attending the ASI is agreed then further transport arrangements can be confirmed.
- 1.1.6 The Applicant suggests ASI is programmed to take one day with the exact date to be agreed with the ExA once the arrangements for the w/c 22<sup>nd</sup> January is fixed. If it is deemed that additional time is needed to undertake the ASI once Interested Parties and the ExA have commented, then the Applicant will look to update the itinerary for Deadline 3.
- 1.1.7 The route and itinerary should be read in conjunction with the suggested Figure 1 West Burton Viewpoint Plan.
