The Wildlife and countryside Act 1981

This is the primary Mechanism for wildlife protection in Britain. The legislation covers 4 areas:-

- 1 Wild life protection of wild bird, their eggs and nest
- 2 Nature conservation, countryside and national parks
- 3 public right of way
- 4 miscellaneous provisions

Wild life act, wild life legislation has evolved in the UK ' to promote the conservation of certain species. It generally prevents the deliberate killing or taking of wild animals and puts in place provisions for protected animals to be taken, for specific purpose and or specific times.

Badgers and Nesting birds, Adders, bats, Butterflies Crickets Dormice.

Hedgerow Regulation 1997

These regulations fall under the local authority and are intended to protect important hedgerows from removal. Owners and managers must request permission from their local authority before removing a hedgerow and it may not be granted if it supports a diverse range or protected species,

Illegal to cut hedges Between 1st March and 31st July. The main breeding season.

Section 9 wildlife and countryside act 1981 Section 9(4) (a)

Prohibits the damage, destruction, or obstruction of access to any structure or place which animals listed in Schedule 5 use for shelter or protection

Protection Of Badgers 1992

This animal welfare legislation protects badgers and their setts and it makes it illegal to wilfully capture, injure or kill a wild badger

Be in possession of a live or dead badger

Destroy or obstruct access to a badger sett

Wild Mammals Act (protection) Act 1996

This protects all wild animals and is more of a conservation act.

Section 53 Countryside Right of way act 2000

Section 53 provides that public right of way over a footpath or bridleway which was created before January 1949, is still a footpath or bridleway on the cut off date and is not shown on a definitive map.

Section 27 Sign posting of footpaths and bridleways

Highways authority shall have power to erect and maintain signposts along any footpaths.

LAND OWNERS AGENT REMOVING THEM

The landowner can not block or divert a public footpath. If the landowner refuses to remove obstruction apply to court for obstruction to be removed,

Restructed Byway is a highway over which the public is entitled to travel on foot, horseback and non mechanical propelled vehicle. (such as pedal cycles

and horse drawn vehicles. There must also be a right to drive animals along restricted byways

Public of way section 31 of the highways act 1980.

The public have used the path for 20 years without interruption. The public were using the path without force, secrecy or permission.

The landowner must keep the right of way free of obstruction. The landowner must not cultivate – except that a cross a field footpath or bridleway may sometimes be cultivated. If it is , reinstated convenient for use, within a fortnight on the first occasion and within 24 hours on any subsequent year.
