I am writing to you to express my concern regarding the Cottam Solar Project. The project will destroy quality agricultural land which we need for our own food production. Taking good productive land out of agricultural use in the middle of a world food crisis would be insane.

The project will also destroy the natural habitat for wildlife as hedgerows, trees and shrubs will be removed to make way for solar panels. We must preserve and protect our wildlife, not destroy it.

The access roads for the Cottam project are narrow country lanes which are not at all suitable for the heavy traffic required for the construction process.
