The large yellow square indicates a temporary operational site., presently put on the DMV behind West Farm cottages. THE LANDONER HAS ALREADY ASKED THE TENANTS TO VACATE THE FIELD, REMOVING SHEEP AND PONY. I am concerned that this is another 'greed' move. The income from the field rent is small compared to that which would be paid to site the works pad.

If the cable route is moved to the south, through the open field, as proposed by ALL RESIDENTS, the landowner of the DMV may lose his income as it may be too far away to be useful. Therefore, of course he will not want any objections raised. Pleased be aware of this and pass it on to Island Green, Cottam Solar and all other parties you think involved.

I look forward to attending the site visit and being informed of the promised geophysical investigation in the southerly field belonging to Mr Pace.
