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### 1 Introduction

# 1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) has been prepared as part of the proposed Cottam Solar Project Development Consent Order (the Application) made by Cottam Solar Project Ltd (the Applicant) to the Secretary of State for Energy Security & Net Zero (the Secretary of State) pursuant to the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008).
- 1.1.2 This SoCG does not seek to replicate information which is available elsewhere within the Application documents. All documents are available on the Planning Inspectorate's website.
- 1.1.3 This SoCG has been produced to confirm to the Examining Authority (ExA) where agreement has been reached between the parties, and where agreement has not yet been reached. SoCGs are an established means in the DCO consenting process of allowing all parties to identify and focus on specific issues that may need to be addressed during the examination.

### 1.2 Parties to this Statement of Common Ground

- 1.2.1 This SoCG has been prepared by (1) Cottam Solar Project Ltd. as the Applicant and (2) Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (Network Rail).
- 1.2.2 Collectively, Cottam Solar Project Ltd. and Network Rail are referred to as 'the parties'.

### 1.3 Terminology

- 1.3.1 In the tables in **Sections 3 5** of this SoCG:
  - "Agreed" indicates where the issue has been resolved.
  - "Not Agreed" indicates a final position, and
  - "Under discussion" indicates where these points will be the subject of ongoing discussion wherever possible to resolve, or refine, the extent of disagreement between the parties.



# 2 Record of Engagement

# 2.1 Summary of consultation

2.1.1 The parties have been engaged in consultation since May 2022. A summary of the meetings and correspondence that has taken place between Cottam Solar Project and Network Rail in relation to the Application is outlined in **Table 2-1**.

21/03/2023	Email	Mark Whitehead (Construction Manager Assistant at Network Rail) confirmed over email to James Youngs (IGP) receipt of enquiry for crossing near Cottam Power Station to progress BAPA (0000302314).
17/04/2023	Email	All three crossing easements passed business and technical clearance. Kelvin Gill (Network Rail) sent Heads of Terms to agree easement to James Youngs (IGP).
05/05/2023	Microsoft Teams Call	Call between Michael Moody (Surveyor at Network Rail), Kelvin Gill (Network Rail) and James Youngs (Cottam Solar Project Ltd) to discuss Heads of Terms for the three easements.
09/05/2023	Email	Dave Franks (Construction Manager at Network Rail) confirmed the location of one signal position within the proximity of the project in an email to James Youngs (Cottam Solar Project Ltd).
