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Statement of Commonality

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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this Document

- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared to provide the Examining Authority (ExA) with the latest position on Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) between Cottam Solar Project Ltd. (the 'Applicant') and statutory consultees, statutory undertakers and other Interested Parties (the 'parties') in relation to the proposed Cottam Solar Project (the 'Scheme').
- 1.1.2 This document provides a position on the commonality on specific points between SoCGs at Deadline 23 (being 21st November 19 December 2023).
- 1.1.3 The Applicant will, for each deadline, update this Statement during the course of the Examination as a record of the progress being made with the various parties. When sufficient progress has been made on agreements between parties, this document will also discuss those areas of commonality between parties to enable the efficient resolution and focusing in on the remaining issues.

1.2 Structure of this Document

- 1.2.1 This Statement of Commonality is structured as follows:
 - Section 2 details the structure of each SoCG document. Table 2.1 provides a full list of SoCGs being produced and offers an overview of the status of each SoCG;

2 Statements of Common Ground

2.1 Structure of SoCGs

2.1.1 Each SoCG has sought to adopt a standard format to ensure consistency in the approach taken to documenting those matters agreed, matters subject to ongoing discussion or matters not agreed, other than where an individual party has expressed a preference for an alternative format.

2.1.2 Each SoCG is structured as follows:

- Section 1 provides an introduction to the SoCG, identifies the relevant parties and describes the purpose of the document;
- Section 2 summarises the parties' engagement undertaken to date; and
- Section 3 details those matters agreed, those matters under discussion and those matters which have not been agreed.

3 Commonality

- 3.1.1 This section of the Statement provides an overview of the topics covered in the SoCGs. Table 3.1 presents, at a high level, where there is commonality in the topics discussed between the Applicant and the parties, or where matters are progressing through discussion, or where matters discussed have reached a final position of 'Not Agreed'.
- 3.1.2 Where a topic is not relevant to a particular party, the cell has been greyed out. Where the topic is relevant to the party, the status is shown as follows:

- 3.1.3 The colour of each cell corresponds to the status figure (as above) in each individual SoCG.
- 3.1.4 At Deadline 23, the Applicant has shared draft SoCG's with a number of parties and is awaiting feedback from them. Therefore, where the Applicant considers there to be a high degree of certainty over matters being agreed and is waiting for confirmation, they are marked as green in Table 3.1.
- 3.1.5 Following the Summary of Commonality in Table 3.1, Section 3.2 outlines the principal outstanding matters which are subject to further discussion before a final position can be reached.

4 Positions at Deadline 23

- 4.1.1 This section provides a summary of the position reached across all SoCGSoCGs being progressed and submitted to Deadline 23. The Applicant will continue to engage with those parties through the examination on matters which are ongoing.
- 4.2 Nottinghamshire County Council & Bassetlaw District Council
- 4.2.1 A meeting was held between the Applicants and the two parties on 14th November to discuss the draft Statement of Common Ground. As a result of the meeting the majority of matters which were still under discussion at Deadline 1 have now been confirmed as agreed.
- 4.2.2 TheAt Deadline 3, the only matters still subject to further discussion relate to the drafting of the DCO and some heritage matters in respect of the written scheme of investigation. An updated SoCG (Rev A) has been submitted for Deadline 2 [EX2/C8.3.1_A] which sets out the updated position.
- 4.3 Lincolnshire County Council
- 4.3.14.2.2 The matters recorded in the SoCG There have been subject no further updates to discussion, through monthly catchups, between the Applicant and the Host Authorities as well as some topic specific meetings e.g. landscape and visual impact. Detailed discussionsthe SoCG submitted at Deadline 2 [REP2-060]. For further details on cultural heritage matters have also taken place with the latest meeting held on 3.10.23 following the Examining Authority's request at , please see the update to the Lincolnshire County Council SoCG which sets out the latest position between those parties on these matters [EX3/C8.3.2_B]. This updated draft of the SoCG also takes account of the ExA's request in Issue Specific Hearing 12 on 5 December 2023 that the mattersareas of agreement and disagreement in relation to the Written Scheme of Investigation be set out clearly for Deadline 1. Feedback on on the final wording of the cultural heritage sections of the SoCG [REP-063] was still awaited from Lincs CC at Deadline 1 submission but has now been provided. An updated WSI between LCC and NCC and the Applicant would be set out in the next version of the document [EX2/C8.3.2_A] responding to the comments raised has been shared with LCC and is submitted at Deadline 2.. SoCG. For further details, please see the Written Summary of the Applicant's Oral Submissions at the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH2) held on 5 December 2023 [EX3/C8.1.21].
- 4.3.2 An updated SoCG will be submitted for Deadline 3 where it is anticipated a number of ongoing matters will become agreed matters.
- 4.3 Lincolnshire County Council



- 4.3.1 An updated SoCG [EX3/C8.3.2_B] has been submitted for Deadline 3 which includes details of the meeting held on 14 December 2023 in response to the request from the Examining Authority at Issue Specific Hearing 5 (ISH5) on the Draft Development Consent Order to identify options for the WSI if the scheme is consented. For further details, please see the Written Summary of the Applicant's Oral Submissions at the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH5) held on 8 December 2023 [EX3/C8.1.26].
- 4.3.2 This updated draft of the SoCG also takes account of the ExA's request in Issue Specific Hearing 2 on 5 December 2023 that areas of agreement and disagreement on the WSI between LCC and NCC and the Applicant would be set out in the next version of the SoCG. For further details, please see the Written Summary of the Applicant's Oral Submissions at the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH2) [EX3/C8.1.21].

4.4 West Lindsey District Council

- 4.4.1 The matters recorded in the SoCG have been subject to discussion, through monthly catchups, between the Applicant and the host local authority. The Applicant has submitted a draft to the party and is awaiting comments back. The matters listed as agreed in Table 3.1 are based on the Applicant's judgement on the high likelihood of them being agreed.
- 4.4.2 The main matters subject to further discussion relate to principle of development, climate change, landscape and visual impact, ecology, transport, noise, socio-economic, tourism and recreation, soils and agriculture and the draft DCO. An updated SoCG will be submitted for Deadline 3 where it is anticipated a number of ongoing matters will become agreed matters.
- 4.4.1 An updated SoCG [EX3/C8.3.3_A] has been submitted for Deadline 3 which sets out the position of West Lindsey District Council and the Applicant relating to the assessment of significant cumulative effects, in response to the request of the ExA at Issue Specific Hearing 4 on 6 December 2023. The text is included as a new row PD-07 in the "matters under discussion" section of the SoCG. The text is currently under review by Lincolnshire County Council and a further update will be provided at Deadline 4. For further details, please also see the Written Summary of the Applicant's Oral Submissions at the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH4) held on 6 December 2023 [EX3/C8.1.23].

4.5 National Highways

- 4.5.1 All matters were agreed between the parties by Deadline 1.
- 4.6 UK Health Security Agency
- 4.6.1 Following extensive discussions between the parties, the Applicant has, at the request of the UK Health Security Agency, produced an 'Updated Air



Quality Impact Assessment of a Solar Panel Fire Incident' [REP-078] and an 'Air Quality Impact Assessment of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) Fire' [REP-079]. The UK Health Security Agency have confirmed this additional modelling satisfactorily addresses their concerns and as such, all matters between the parties are agreed.

4.7 Upper Witham Internal Drainage Board

4.7.1 All matters were agreed between the Parties by Deadline 1. <u>Since Deadline</u> 2. the IDB have been asked to confirm in writing to PINS that the IDB agrees to the disapplication in Article 6 of the DCO and that they are happy for this to be added to the signed version of the SoCG. It is anticipated that this confirmation can be appended to the signed version of the SoCG for Deadline 4.

4.8 The Environment Agency

- 4.8.1 The Parties have agreed all matters within the draft SoCG except for those relating to the potential impact of Electromagnetic Fields (EMF) upon ecology. This issue was added to the draft SoCG for Deadline 1 at the request of the Environment Agency (10.11.23) following it being raised as an issue in a written representation [EN010131-000735] by a member of the public during the Gate Burton Solar Project examination. It is shown as an 'under discussion' matter within the draft SoCG (included under 'Ecology and Biodiversity and 'Other Environmental Matters' in Table 3.1). Since Deadline 1, the Environment Agency has confirmed that it is happy that the Statement of Common Ground sets out the agreed position between the parties, with all matters other than potential EMF impacts upon ecology now agreed.
- 4.8.2 The Applicant has now prepared an EMF Risk Assessment which is appended to the Written Summary of the Applicant's Oral Submissions and Responses at Issue Specific Hearing 3 [EX3/C8.1.22] and is in the process of arranging a meeting to discuss this with the Environment Agency.

4.9 Network Rail

4.9.1 The draft SoCG was sent to Network Rail in April 2023. The applicant has attempted to engage with Network Rail on a number of occasions since then to try and progress agreement of the SoCG. Since Deadline 1 the draft SoCG has also been shared with Network Rail's solicitors for review and comment, but to date no feedback has been received.

4.10 Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust

- 4.10.1 All matters have been agreed between the Parties by Deadline 1.
- 4.11 Natural England



- 4.11.1 Extensive discussions have been undertaken between the parties with agreement alreadynow reached on ecologyall matters and landscape issues as indicated ina signed version of the draft document. The ApplicantSoCG submitted for Deadline 3 [EX3/C8.3.11_B]. Some further text has now responded to Natural England's requests been added into the Outline Soil Management Plan to provide some additional clarity on matters related to the reinstatement of soils and best and most valuable agricultural land. These amendments are included within the Rev A version of the Outline Soil Management Plan submitted for deadline Deadline 3 [EX3/C6.3.19.2 [EX2/C8.3.11_A] and it is hoped that all matters can be agreed by Deadline 3._B].
- 4.12 Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust
- 4.12.1 All matters have been agreed between the parties by Deadline 1.
- 4.13 Gate Burton Energy Park, Tillbridge Solar Project and West Burton Solar Project
- 4.13.1 The All matters were agreed between the parties by Deadline 2. Nevertheless, the parties have continued discussions as they progress through their respective Examinations and, in the case of the Tillbridge Solar Project, impending submission. An updated version of the SoCG has now been signed and is submitted at Cottam Deadline 2 [EX2/C8.3.13_A]. An equivalent SoCG has been submitted into the Gate Burton Solar Project examination for Deadline 5 as an update continue to the previous version [REP-017].
- 4.13.24.13.1 The parties have now reached agreement work together on the Joint Report on Interrelationships between the four projects [EX2(JIR), an update of which will be submitted at the Gate Burton Solar Project's next examination deadline, which is 21 December 2023 (Deadline 6). The same JIR will then be submitted into the Cottam and West Burton examinations, the same day or very shortly thereafter, as a late Deadline 3 submission for this Examination [EX3/C8.1.8_A]. The teams have reviewed the applications submitted by the other developers to compare sections on cumulative impacts and have continued to look for further ways to collaborate and reduce cumulative impacts (e.g. on access). The report is the joint cooperation agreement and each Scheme's respective protective provisions for the benefit of other parties, are contained within the respective Schemes' draft Development Consent Orders.B].
- 4.14 Anglian Water
- 4.14.1 A signed version of the SoCG is submitted for Deadline 2 [EX2/C8.3.14_A].

 All matters are now agreed. As compared to the Deadline 1 version of the SoCG, the signed version has been amended to provide further clarity about



the use of rainwater harvesting as requested by Anglian Water. All matters were agreed between the parties by Deadline 2.

4.15 Historic England

4.14.14.15.1 The areas of agreement and disagreement between the parties were set out at Deadline 1 and this position has not changed.
