

I was present at the Open Floor Hearing and concur with the oral representations made by parties regarding the need for a robust assessment on wellbeing.

The applicant has used out of date data regarding well-being that is not appropriate for this project which is unprecedented in size and scale.

In the applicants summary at the open floor hearing he stated inaccurate and flawed statements.

Lincolnshire has no history of powering up the U.K. The power stations are in Nottinghamshire. The heritage is in farming and we must preserve the land for food and there are recent reports by the national audit office that our finite land should be retained for food production.

There is no government policy for ground mounted Solar of this size and scale. In the national policy statements it mentions Solar farms on a much smaller scale and that all sources of land contaminated land, industrial land and brownfield land should be a preference.
