I am not a farmer in Lincolnshire but a local resident and I object to this scheme on several grounds.

1. The solar panels will not provide electricity at night.
2. They will not provide the same level of power during the winter months when the days are shorter.
3. The suggestion that the land can be returned to agriculture is a facility as the infrastructure will have to be demolished .
4. Most important, we keep being sold on the land that is to be used is poor quality, Lincolnshire provides some 12% of the nations food, if this were lost it would mean more reliance on foreign imports at a greater cost.
