The size and scale of the proposed Cottam solar project together with the other proposed solar projects in the area are disproportionate and vastly over-scaled. The cumulative impact of these projects will destroy quality agricultural land which we need for food production and our food security. The war in Ukraine has given added emphasis to how important food security is for the resilience of this country and for many of the most vulnerable in our society. They will also ruin the natural habitat for wildlife and dominate the landscape. The access roads for the Cottam project are narrow country lanes which are not at all suitable for the heavy traffic required for the construction process.

The energy storage facility is planned to be one of the largest battery storage facilities in the world. The risk of fire, flood and chemical leak is enormous. What health and safety measures will be put in place to protect the houses nearby?

Lincolnshire must continue as the breadbasket of England.
