



Thanks for this summary of actions.

LVIA – as discussed, we feel that on the available information the suggested views are sensible / about right save for the absence of views from the north which seem to be missed for reasons that are not clear. The storage and distribution park at Sevington (bought by DfT and now IBF) was the subject of an ES and views from the Downs were considered so I can't see why the same landscape and visual impact assessment would not apply to something only a relatively small distance further eastwards down the M20 corridor.

Please see the attached pdf with my suggested views from the AONB Downs that is identified as being in the ZTV. There is 'Badgers Mount' further to the east on Pilgrims' Way but I can't vouch for it personally (whereas the others I can).








Above The Crown, Wye, Kent Downs – AONB and on the North Downs Way and popular local PROW (in dark green - not definitive) walk
