

Having attended the meeting last week the barrister for the Stonestreet Green solar seemed to have no understanding on how such a huge solar farm would impact the village of Aldington. He spoke about 'streets' rather than country lanes with no lighting and had no understanding of how narrow our lanes are and how it would impact traffic to and from the village.
