

I strongly object to the enormous size of the Stonestreet Green Solar Project as it is taking over prime agricultural farmland that is not a brown field site. This farmland is healthy and able to produce much needed crops and has done so for many years. Our farming land is being swallowed up by more and more development and we are being very shortsighted on where our future food will come from. Also what will happen to the site after the solar panels come to the end of their lifetime say in 20-25 years - the land will become a brown field site and therefore be suitable only for housing/building development. This will increase the volume of traffic on the local roads which are in an extremely poor condition and are busier already.

During the construction of the project our daily commute and school run with access through the village and on to the A20 and M20 will be severely impacted - road closures will result in surrounding roads being used and cause more congestion/delays/accidents as they are not wide enough for the increased traffic.

I am in favour of producing green energy for the future but this project's size is completely unacceptable.
