

Statements of Common Ground

The Applicant has continued to progress Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) with all Interested Parties identified by the Examining Authority in its Rule 6 letter. Fourteen initial SoCG were submitted at Deadline 1. For Deadline 2 the Applicant submitted initial SoCGs with the following Interested Parties:

- Initial SoCG Orsted IPs
- Initial commercial fisheries joint SoCG (NFFO, WFA and WFC)
- Initial commercial fisheries joint SoCG (Fisheries Stakeholders)
- Initial SoCG NRW

The Applicant will continue to progress the SoGCs with all Interested Parties throughout the examination.

Accompanied Site Visit (ASI)

As mentioned in S_PD_2_The Applicant's response to the Examining Authority's Rule 4, 6, 9 and 13 letter, the Applicant does not consider an accompanied site inspection to be necessary as the development is entirely at sea. No Interested Party has requested an accompanies site visit. Therefore, the Applicant has not submitted a draft itinerary for any ASI.

The draft DCO

The Applicant has submitted an updated draft DCO (S_D2_7) in clean and track versions. An updated Schedule of Changes to the Draft DCO (S_D2_8) is also submitted.

The Applicant's Errata Sheet at the Deadline 2

Since Deadline 1 a few more minor discrepancies have been identified within the application documents. An updated Errata Sheet (S_D2_6) has been submitted at Deadline 2 to reflect these minor discrepancies.


