

Update of Measures to minimise disturbance to marine mammals and rafting birds from transiting vessels document (APP-070)

The Applicant has been made aware (late on 16.01.2025) that Natural England's position on the conclusion of no AEoI for the red-throated diver population of the Liverpool Bay SPA will be contingent on some additional wording being added to the Measures to minimise disturbance to marine mammals and rafting birds from transiting vessels document (APP-070). The wording that the Applicant understands Natural England wishes to see added is as follows:

- selecting routes that avoid known aggregations of birds;
- maintaining direct transit routes (to minimise transit distances through areas used by divers);
- avoidance of over-revving of engines (to minimise noise disturbance).


The plan should also confirm that these and other measures relating to Natural England's redthroated diver Best Practice Protocol should be applied both within the SPA and out to 2km from the SPA boundary.

The Applicant is keen for the Examining Authority to be able to issue a REIS document that will require as minimal update as possible on the 06.02.2025. Therefore, the Applicant confirms that it has committed to the proposed wording from Natural England within Section 1.3 of an updated version of the Measures to minimise disturbance to marine mammals and rafting birds from transiting vessels document, which is submitted with document reference S_D5_23 to the Applicants response to Deadline 5. The Applicant has not had sufficient time to confirm that it made these changes to Natural England ahead of Deadline 5 (but will do so in the coming days).

Artificial Intelligence (AI)

The Applicant can confirm that Artificial Intelligence has not been used to create or alter any application documents either submitted at application or provided for the Examination to date.
