



**Planning Act 2008 – section 61 and section 65**

**Application by Mona Offshore Wind Limited for an order granting development consent for the Mona Offshore Wind Farm (EN010137)**

**Amendment to the appointment of the Examining Authority**

The above application was accepted for examination on 21 March 2024. On 3 April 2024 a document was published confirming that Caroline Jones (lead), Jason Rowlands, Jessica Powis, Graham Hobbins and Andrew Harwood had been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application for the Mona Offshore Wind Farm. These appointments were made in accordance with the Planning Inspectorate's Conflict of Interest Policy.

Due to personal circumstances, Andrew Harwood is no longer able to continue in his role as a member of the Panel for this project and has submitted his resignation from the panel under s66(3) of the Planning Act 2008.
