**Mona Offshore Wind Farm - Agenda for Issue Specific Hearing 4 (ISH 4 Offshore Matters) and Issue Specific Hearing 5 (ISH 5 draft DCO)**

We refer to the above application for development consent.

In particular, Trinity House notes that the Examining Authority (ExA) have requested Trinity House's attendance to ISH 4 and to ISH 5 on 23 and 24 October 2024 respectively.

Whilst Trinity House is grateful to the ExA for its consideration in this regard, we would wish to highlight please that Trinity House does not have any issues of concern to raise, or intend to make representations, at either ISH4 (offshore matters), or ISH5 (draft DCO) at this juncture.

On the matter of the draft DCO, Trinity House would confirm that it is in ongoing discussion with the applicant regarding this. Having reviewed the current published version of the draft DCO provided by the applicant at Deadline 2 (D2 [REP2-004]), Trinity House does not have any issues to raise regarding its provisions at this juncture.

Trinity House is also in ongoing discussions regarding the Statement of Common Ground between the applicant and itself.

Trinity House is continuing to monitor the Examination process for any specific written questions that may be raised by the ExA relevant to it and will, of course, respond as appropriate thereto to the ExA in writing should this be the case.

Trinity House is also continuing to monitor the further iterations of the draft DCO, as and when these are produced by the applicant at the relevant Examination deadlines, and published on the Planning Inspectorate's website.

On this basis, Trinity House would respectfully advise that it does not intend to attend the ISH 4 or ISH 5 this week and would be grateful if the ExA could perhaps be informed accordingly please as regards Trinity House's current position on matters as regards the Examination process, in case this is helpful to the ExA.
