The parties are currently agreeing rental figures and plans are being prepared, good progress is being made to agree the final form of the Property Agreement. It is Network Rail's position that it will not withdraw its objection until the Framework Agreement has been completed, but the parties are in the process of signing the Framework Agreement and that confirmation is expected to be shortly forthcoming. Updates on the position of negotiations with Statutory Undertakers is set out in the Land Rights Tracker (AS-021). The Applicant therefore considers that a Final Position Statement of Common Ground between itself and Network Rail is not necessary at this stage as there is no further information to provide the Examining Authority. The Applicant will keep this position under review as the Examination progresses. on Statutory Undertakers and Crown Land (S D7 31).
