



Application by Mona Offshore Wind Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Mona Offshore Wind Farm (Case Reference: EN010137)

Examining Authority’s note of Unaccompanied Site Inspection 3 (USI3) undertaken on 7 and 8 January 2025.

The Examining Authority (ExA) undertook its third Unaccompanied Site Inspection (USI3) on 7 and 8 January 2025 to support its Examination of the application by Mona Offshore Wind Limited for the Mona Offshore Wind Farm.

The inspections were undertaken on public walking routes, public roads, and public rights of way. Graham Hobbins was present for the ExA on 7 and 8 January.

The route was planned in order to view specific viewpoints (VP) within the Isle of Anglesey National Landscape (IoANL) which have been discussed during the course of the Examination. These viewpoints have been assessed in the Seascape, Landscape Visual Impact assessment and were located at various distances from the proposed array site, within the Zone of Theoretical Visibility (ZTV).

Unless otherwise stated, all visits were undertaken on foot.
