Application EN010138 for the Rivenhall Integrated Waste Management Facility by Indaver Rivenhall Limited.

On behalf of Indaver Rivenhall Limited ('the Applicant') please find enclosed the Certificate of Compliance with section 56 of the Planning Act 2008.

Notice under section 56 of the Planning Act 2008, Regulation 8 of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 and Regulation 16 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 was initially issued on 5th January 2024 to the required persons identified in accordance with section 56.
