#### Hi Paul.

I have an urgent query on Byers Gill.

I received on 29 August a letter that arrived at an NH office a communication related to the Rule 8 Letter for Byers Gill Solar Farm 30 July. This includes 2 inspector questions that were due yesterday (though PI have asked that if we reply asap):

- CA.1.8 All planning and highway authorities and National Highways: In your role as the Local Planning Authority and the Highway Authority are you aware of: 1. Any reasonable alternatives to CA or Temporary Possession (TP) for land sought by the Applicant?
- CA.1.17 National Highways National Highways [AS-009] are requested to comment on the Applicant's approach to on-road cabling in relation to CA and the need, or not, for CA or TP of land.

Referring to the original red line on the map I received for Byres Gill I would say that the land inside the red line is close to but not encroaching on NH operated highway land. Should plans have changed and with this some incursion onto our Highway Land, as we have to continue to operate the SRN, I would consider that whether or not land is Compulsory Acquired or Temporarily Possessed (CA or TP options mentioned) National Highways need to continue to operate the SRN and would refer such an issue to our operations team who may set up a Section 278 or similar in line with Highways Act to do the works.

I will advise Planning inspectorate as such referring them to yourself, unless I here from you.
