The SoCC will remain on the website for the duration of the consultation period.

Following publication of the SoCC, the Applicant will undertake a statutory period of consultation and invite comments on the Project between the 26 October 2023 and 11.59pm on the 7 December 2023.


Details of the statutory consultation and how to be involved are set out in the SoCC. Any person may comment on the Proposed Development.
