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## 0. Introduction

### 0.1. Purpose of this document

- 0.1.1. This Guide to the Application **[EN010140/APP/1.4]** has been prepared on behalf of Enso Green Holdings D Limited (the ‘Applicant’) in relation to an application for a Development Consent Order (DCO) for the Helios Renewable Energy Project (‘the Proposed Development’). The application for the DCO (the DCO Application) is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate (PINS), who will provide a recommendation on whether to grant a DCO, to the Secretary of State (SoS) for Energy Security and Net Zero, who will make a decision pursuant to the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008).
- 0.1.2. This **Guide to the Application (Guide) [EN010140/APP/1.4]** to help the Examining Authority (ExA) and Interested Parties understand the Application by signposting documents that make up the Application. This guide also provides a brief overview of the application. This **Guide to the Application [EN010140/APP/1.4]** is an iterative document and is subject to be updated at each Examination deadline. This is to help signpost updated documents as well as record new documents submitted as part of the Examination.
- 0.1.3. It is important to note that due to the size of the Application, this document does not cover every document submitted as part of the Application. A full list of submitted documents can be found in the Electronic Index and **Table 4 Application Documents Tracker** which can be found at the end of this document.
- 0.1.4. Regulation 5 of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (as amended) (APFP Regulations) sets out the documents that all DCO applications must include.
- 0.1.5. Regulation 6 of the APFP Regulations sets out the specific documentation required in support of the DCO applications for the particular types of development, including generating stations and grid connections.
- 0.1.6. The Proposed Development constitutes Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) development and, therefore, the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the EIA regulations) and requirements therein apply.

0.1.7. This Guide provides an overview of the documents that have been submitted in order to meet the APFP Regulations, the EIA regulations and section 37 of the Planning Act 2008.

0.1.8. The paragraph numbering of this document has been formatted to align with the reference numbers of the Application documents.

## **0.2. The Applicant**

0.2.1. Enso Green Holdings D Limited (the ‘Applicant’) is a joint-venture partnership between Enso Energy and Cero Generation. Enso Energy is one of the UK’s most experienced renewable energy developers, with an unparalleled focus on solar energy. Cero Generation is a leading solar energy company, working across Europe to support the transition to a net-zero future. Further information on the Applicant will be provided within a separate **Funding Statement [EN010140/APP/4.4]** that will be submitted as part of the DCO Application.

## **0.3. Overview of the Proposed Development**

0.3.1. The Proposed Development comprises the installation of ground mounted solar arrays, battery energy storage system (BESS) and associated development comprising grid connection infrastructure and other infrastructure integral to the construction, operation (including maintenance) and decommissioning of the development for the delivery of over 50 megawatts (MW) of electricity.

0.3.2. A more detailed technical description of the Proposed Development is included within the **Chapter 3: Site and Development Description [EN010140/APP/6.1.3]** of the **ES**.

## **0.4. Application Documents**

0.4.1. The documents submitted in support of the Application have been grouped together as per *Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects – Advice Note six: preparation and submission of application documents – May 2022*.

7. Other documents	Contains additional documents pertaining to the Proposed Development, required by the APFP Regulations regulation 6 and considered by the Applicant to be required to support the application in accordance with APFP Regulations regulation 5(2)(q).

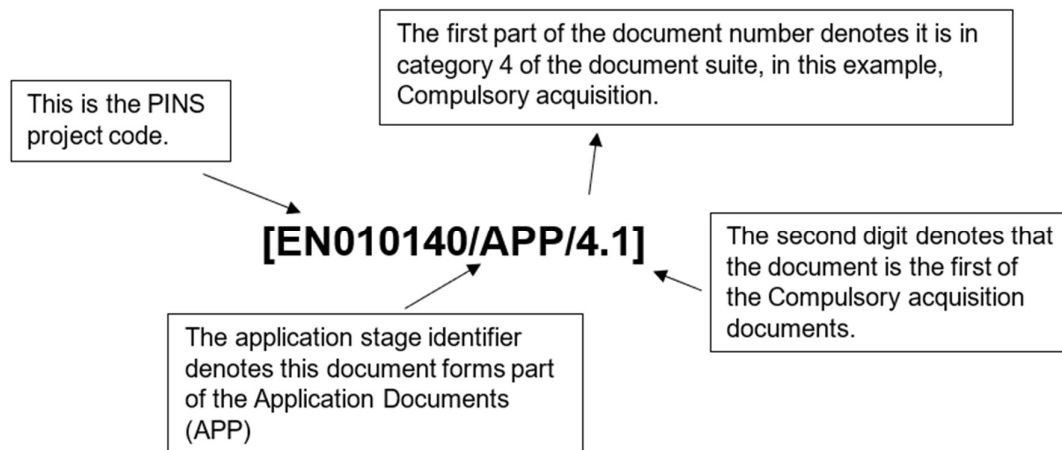

## 0.5. Document Numbering

0.5.1. The documents submitted as part of the Application for Development Consent each have a unique reference number, which follow a consistent numbering format.

0.5.2. This reference number includes the PINS project code, application stage identifier and individual document number. Individual document numbers contain two to four digits, and these denote the document type and where relevant, the chapter and/or appendix number. Figure 1 provides an example and explanation of the reference number format.

## 0.6. ES Document Numbering

0.6.1. The Environmental Statement (ES) is assembled in four volumes:

Volume 1 – Main Chapters

Volume 2 – Figures

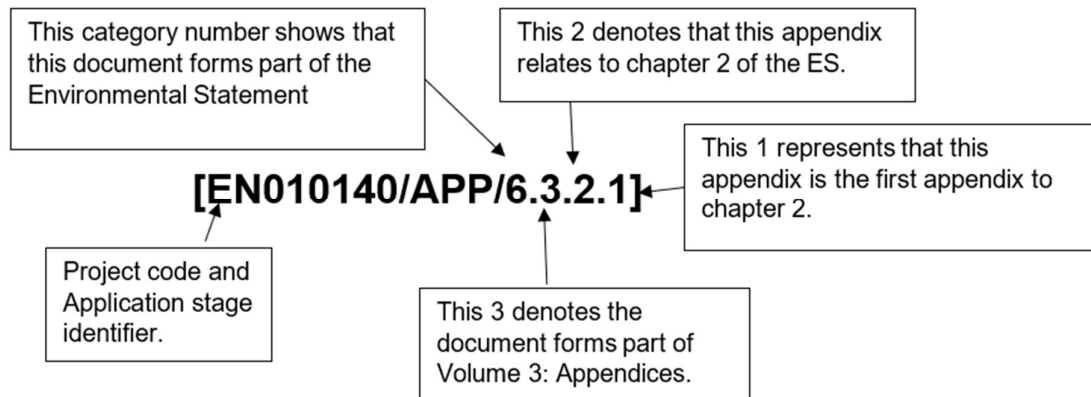
Volume 3 – Appendices

Volume 4 – Non Technical Summary



- 0.6.2. The Environmental Statement referencing broadly follows the criteria set out above. Some of the documents within the ES have a four-digit document number as part of their document reference, this distinguishes that the document is either a figure or appendix.
- 0.6.3. The main chapters will always start with **[EN010140/APP/6.1.x]**. Figures will always start with **[EN010140/APP/6.2.x.x]** and appendices will always start with **[EN010140/APP/6.3.x.x]**.
- 0.6.4. For example, Appendix 2.1 of the Environmental Statement would be identified as **[EN010140/APP/6.3.2.1]**.

- 0.6.5. Following submission and acceptance of the DCO Application to PINS, the Examination Library accessed via the PINS website will allocate each document a separate reference number. Updated versions of the Application Document Tracker found at the end of this document will also include the PINS Examination Library reference numbers.

## 1. Application Form

### 1.1. Document Reference 1.1 – Application Cover Letter

1.1.1. The **Application Cover Letter [EN010140/APP/1.1]** provides a brief overview of the Proposed Development and an introduction to the Application. The submission of this document is under Regulation 5(2)(q) of the APFP Regulations.

### 1.2. Document Reference 1.2 – Guide to the Application

1.2.1. The purpose of the **Guide to the Application [EN010140/APP/1.2]** is set out in Section 0.1 above. The document provides an overview of the Application documents. This document also contains an Application Documents tracker which contains the status and revision of each document submitted. This document will be updated at each Examination deadline where appropriate. This document is submitted under Regulation 5(2)(q) of the APFP Regulations.

### 1.3. Document Reference 1.3 – Application Form

1.3.1. The **Application Form [EN010140/APP/1.3]** is the standard form required under Regulation 5(1) of the APFP Regulations and Section 37(3)(b) of the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008).

### 1.4. Document Reference 1.4 - Section 55 Checklist

1.4.1. The **Section 55 Checklist [EN010140/APP/1.4]** provides a schedule of compliance, completed by the Applicant to demonstrate that the DCO Application can be accepted in accordance with Section 55 of the Planning Act 2008.

### 1.5. Document Reference 1.5 – Electronic Application Index

1.5.1. The **Electronic Application Index [EN010140/APP/1.5]** provides a list of all Application documents, including electronic file names, document reference numbers and document authors for all Application documents.

## 2. Plans

### 2.1. Document Reference 2.1 - Location and Order Limits Plan

2.1.1. The **Location and Order Limits Plan [EN010140/APP/2.1]** identifies the location of the Proposed Development in its wider geographical context in accordance with Regulation 5(2)(o).

### 2.2. Document Reference 2.2 – Land Plan

2.2.1. The **Land Plan [EN010140/APP/2.2]** is required under Regulation 5(2)(i) of the APFP Regulations. They correspond and should be read alongside the **Book of Reference [EN010140/APP/4.1]**. These plans set out:

- Land required for or affected by the Proposed Development;
- Land over which it is proposed to exercise powers of Compulsory Acquisition or any right to use land or impose restrictions;
- Any land in relation to which it is proposed to extinguish easements, servitudes and other private rights.

### 2.3. Document Reference 2.3 – Works Plan

2.3.1. In accordance with Regulation 5(2)(j), shows the **Works Plan [EN010140/APP/2.3]** shows the location of the works and the limits within which the Proposed Development and works may be carried out. The areas on the Works Plans are numbered and correspond with the numbered works set out in Schedule 1 of the **Draft DCO [EN010140/APP/3.1]**.

### 2.4. Document Reference 2.4 – Access and Rights of Way Plan

2.4.1. In accordance with Regulation 5(2)(k), this **Access and Rights of Way Plan [EN010140/APP/2.4]** plan shows existing and proposed pathing and highway works within and immediately surrounding the Order Limits.

**2.5. Document Reference 2.5 – Statutory and Non-Statutory Nature Conservation Designations Plan**

2.5.1. In accordance with Regulation 5(2)(l), the **Statutory and Non-Statutory Nature Conservation Designations Plan [EN010140/APP/2.5]** sets out the nature conservation sites, protected sites, important habitats or other diversity features in the vicinity of the Proposed Development.

**2.6. Document Reference 2.6 – Statutory and Non-Statutory Historic Environment Designations Plan**

2.6.1. In accordance with Regulation 5(2)(m), the **Statutory and Non-Statutory Historic Environment Designations Plan [EN010140/APP/2.6]** shows statutory or non-statutory historic or scheduled monument sites/features of the historic environment including scheduled monuments, World Heritage sites, listed buildings, and other historic structures, archaeological sites, and registered battlefields in the vicinity of the Proposed Development.

### **3. Draft Development Consent Order and Related Documents**

#### **3.1. Document Reference 3.1 – Draft Development Consent Order**

3.1.1. The **Draft Development Consent Order (dDCO) [EN010140/APP/3.1]** contains the powers sought by the Applicant to carry out, operate and maintain the Proposed Development which is described in Schedule 1 of the dDCO, this document is required under Regulation 5(2)(b).

#### **3.2. Document Reference 3.2 – Explanatory Memorandum**

3.2.1. The **Explanatory Memorandum [EN010140/APP/3.2]** explains the provisions in the dDCO setting out their effect and reasoning behind their inclusion. This document is required to be submitted under Regulation 5(2)(c).

#### **3.3. Document Reference 3.3 – Consents and Licences Position Statement**

3.3.1. The purpose of the **Consents and Licences Position Statement [EN010140/APP/3.3]** document is to provide information on the additional consents and licences that are or may be required to construct and operate the Proposed Development.

3.3.2. This document has been produced to meet the requirements of Section 24 of the prescribed **Application Form [EN010140/APP/1.3]**.

#### **3.4. Draft Development Consent Order Word Version**

3.4.1. A word version of the dDCO provided for the use of The Planning Inspectorate.

## 4. Compulsory Acquisition Information

### 4.0. Overview

4.0.1. The following documents are required because powers of Compulsory Acquisition of land, interests and/or rights are being sought in the Application.

### 4.1. Document Reference 4.1 – Book of Reference

4.1.1. Regulation 5(2)(d) requires applications for an order for development consent to be accompanied by “where applicable, a book of reference”. **The Book of Reference (BoR) [EN010140/APP/4.1]** corresponds with the Land Plans and identifies all parties who own or occupy land and / or have an interest in or right over land affected by the proposal, and / or who may be entitled to make a ‘relevant claim’ as defined in Section 57 of the Planning Act 2008. Overview

4.1.2. This category contains the plans provided to accompany the dDCO Application pursuant to Section 5(2) of the APFP Regulations. These plans form part of the dDCO Application as they identify Order limits, the locations of the works or are related to the powers sought within the DCO.

### 4.2. Document Reference 4.2 – Statement of Reasons

4.2.1. The **Statement of Reasons [EN010140/APP/4.2]** sets out the reasons for the inclusion of compulsory acquisition powers within the draft DCO in order that the Applicant can acquire the land interests required for the construction and operation (including maintenance) of the Proposed Development that is not already in its possession. It also explains why powers are necessary to enable the Applicant to use land temporarily and acquire, suspend, interfere with, or extinguish rights over land and impose restrictive covenants.

### 4.3. Document Reference 4.3 – Funding Statement

4.3.1. The **Funding Statement [EN010140/APP/4.3]** details how the Proposed Development, including any compulsory purchase acquisition, would be funded as per Regulation 5(2)(h).

## 5. Reports

### 5.0. Overview

5.0.1. To support the Application, several technical reports which are not related to the Environmental Statement have been produced. The contents of these reports contained within section 5 are summarised below.

### 5.1. Document Reference 5.1 – Consultation Report

5.1.1. Section 37(3)(c) of the Planning Act 2008 requires that applications for Development Consent are accompanied by a **Consultation Report [EN010140/APP/5.1]**. The report details the consultation undertaken by the Applicant before the submission of the Application. This includes formal and informal forms of consultation, and the statutory consultation undertaken pursuant to the Planning Act 2008. The report summarises the responses received and explains how the Applicant has had regard to those responses.

### 5.2. Document Reference 5.2 – Consultation Report Appendices

5.2.1. Documents falling under the reference 5.2... denote an appendix to the Consultation Report. These include documents that demonstrate compliance with Section 42 and 43 of the Planning Act 2008.

## 6. Environmental Statement

### 6.0. Overview

- 6.0.1. The documents submitted in this category relate to the Environmental Statement (ES), as well as associated technical and environmental reports. Applicants are required to submit an Environmental Statement under Regulation 5(2)(a) of the APFP Regulations. The ES has been prepared under the provisions of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017.
- 6.0.2. The Environmental Statement reports on the findings of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process as well as providing general information on the Proposed Development.
- 6.0.3. This summary of the Environmental Statement will not cover every document submitted, a full list of documents can be found in the Electronic Index and the Application Document Tracker, this will include associated appendices and figures.
- 6.0.4. The Environmental Statement is divided into four volumes:
- Volume 1 – Main Chapters, contains the written chapters of the Environmental Statement
  - Volume 2 – Figures
  - Volume 3- Appendices
  - Volume 4 – Non-Technical Summary (NTS)

## 7. Other

### 7.0. Overview

7.0.1. This category contains all other documents which the Applicant has considered to adhere with APFP Regulation 5(2)(q) and/or which are considered to by the Applicant to be required to support the Application further.

### 7.1. Document Reference 7.1 – Planning Statement

7.1.1. The **Planning Statement [EN010140/APP/7.1]** demonstrates how the Proposed Development accords with relevant planning policy and legislation. The Planning Statement also contains the Statement of Need, which demonstrates the need for the Proposed Development and extends the case made in the National Policy Statements relevant to this Application. An Alternative Site Assessment is also provided as an appendix to the Planning Statement. The Planning Statement also contains appendices, which are denoted with the reference numbers 7.1.1-7.1.4.

### 7.2. Document Reference 7.2 – Design and Access Statement

7.2.1. The **Design and Access Statement (DAS) [EN010140/APP/7.2]** details the operational design and access of the Proposed Development, explaining the how the design responds to its surroundings and achieves its design objectives.

### 7.3. Document Reference 7.3 – Grid Connection Statement

7.3.1. In accordance with Regulation 6(a)(i) of the APFP Regulations, the **Grid Connection Statement [EN010140/APP/7.4]** discusses who will be responsible for designing and building the connection to the electricity grid.

### 7.4. Document Reference 7.4 – Site Specific Risk Engagement Document (SSRED)

7.4.1. The **Site Specific Risk Engagement Document (SSRED) [EN010140/APP/7.5]** demonstrates how the Applicant has taken account of the Planning Practice Guidance (PPG) and specifically details the engagement undertaken with North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service (NYFRS).

## 7.5. Document Reference 7.5 - Flood Risk Assessment

7.5.1. The **Flood Risk Assessment (FRA) [EN010140/APP/7.5]** provides flood risk information to support the DCO application.

## 7.6. Document Reference 7.6 - Transport Assessment

7.6.1. The **Transport Assessment [EN010140/APP/7.6]** provides an overview of the potential effects of the Proposed Development in transport terms. A separate outline **Construction Traffic Management Plan (oCTMP) [EN010140/APP/6.3.5.2]** has been provided as an appendix to the Transport assessment.

## 7.7. Document Reference 7.7 - Statutory Nuisances Statement

7.7.1. In accordance with Regulation 5(2)(f), the **Statutory Nuisances Statement [EN010140/APP/7.7]** sets out the appropriate mitigation measures to ensure that the Proposed Development has no significant effects that would give rise to a statutory nuisance.

## 7.8. Document Reference 7.8 - Statements Of Common Ground Status

7.8.1. A Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) is a statement produced collaboratively between the Applicant and another party to provide an understanding of the status of discussions and negotiations between the Applicant and the other party.

7.8.2. SoCGs are currently under discussion and have not been included in the initial submission of application documents. They will be updated throughout the examination to reflect the current position between the parties on a variety of topics, with the expectation that the first drafts of these documents will be published during the course of the Examination.

7.8.3. A document that summarises the status of each SoCG has been prepared that will be updated at each deadline to reflect these additional documents.

7.8.4. Below are the draft SoCGs which are being prepared with key interested parties:
